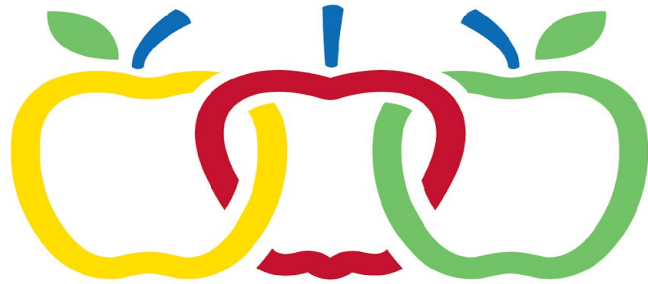

Context for Academic Data

Academic Data Collection Challenge #1:

Progress monitoring of grades has historically been done at the site level.

Solution:

Moving forward, process will be centralized by Assistant Supt. of AC&I with bi-monthly progress monitoring team meetings. Will include district-wide data reporting and analysis each quarter.



Context for Academic Data

Academic Data Collection Challenge #2:

Infinite Campus only provides data for time period report is requested.

Solution:

Assistant Supt. of AC&I has worked with Tech Services Department to develop a quarterly report so that longitudinal comparison can be made for progress monitoring grades (failures/incompletes).



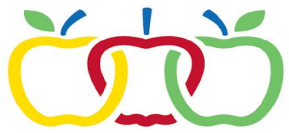
Context for Academic Data

Moving forward, process will be centralized by Assistant Supt. of AC&I.

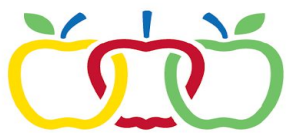


Essential Question #1

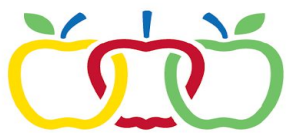
Students with an Incomplete have an additional two weeks to earn a potential letter grade for that course before it becomes an F.

Essential Question #2 Takeaways

- Greatest discrepancy is between EL & Non EL groups
- There is an overrepresentation in % of Fs within service groups:

	% of Enrollment	% with 1 or more F	△ in Representation
English Learners	6.68%	15.83%	2.37X increase
FRAM	25.18%	53.70%	2.13X increase
SwD	11.76%	22.52%	1.91X increase

- Need to dig into universal instruction and possible root causes

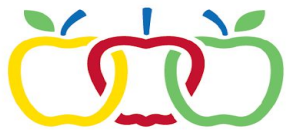
