Please screen yourself daily before coming to school/work. Are you experiencing:

## **ONE** of the following symptoms:

- New repetitive cough
- New loss of taste or smell
- Shortness of breath/trouble breathing

## **OR TWO** of the following symptoms:

- Fever (100.4+)\* or chills
- Diarrhea\*
- Nausea and/or Vomiting\*
- Sore throat
- Fatique
- Runny nose or nasal congestion
- Headache
- Muscle or body aches

\*If you are experiencing these symptoms, please stay home until you are symptom free for 24 hours without use of medication.



Please stay home, families must notify their school. Staff must add sick leave into Frontline. Get a PCR test.

Has a household member tested positive for COVID?

YES You are a "close contact" if ANYONE in your household tests positive for COVID-19.

What should I do if anyone in my household is COVID-19 positive? It depends if you are vaccinated and if you have symptoms, see the more specific questions below:

You may come to school/work Continue daily monitoring for symptoms.

Anyone in your household is COVID-19 positive and you ARE vaccinated:

Anyone in your household is COVID-19 positive and you are **NOT** vaccinated:

Are you vaccinated & without symptoms? You are able to go to

school/work.


Are you vaccinated and have symptoms?

Stay home and get a PCR test.

Did you or your child receive a positive COVID test?

Remain at home until at least 10 days have passed since symptom onset AND at least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without use of medication AND other symptoms have improved

- Families must call their student's school.
- Employees must call HR at (920) 832-6161. Staff should add sick leave into Frontline.



Stay home and monitor yourself for symptoms and get a PCR test. The positive case should self-isolate. Use the 7/10 day quarantine guidance (from the last date of contact) for return to school/work. If you are unable to isolate from the positive case, your quarantine starts at the end of the infected (positive) person's isolation.

You can return to work/school:

- After day 7 after receiving a negative PCR test result (test must occur on day 5 or later)
- After day 10 without testing
- **OR** after your quarantine period is complete.
