

Re: Request for a Table of Organization Change

The Fire Department's current Table of Organization includes one Fire Protection Engineer. The previous Fire Protection Engineer retired on January 3, 2022. Despite extensive efforts over the past five months to fill the position, a candidate has not been found. The Fire Department is requesting to modify the table of organization from a Civilian Fire Protection Engineer to a Public Education Specialist/Civilian Fire Inspector. This position was part the Fire Department between 1985 and 2010. The position was eliminated from the budget in 2011.


The Fire Protection Engineer position was responsible for several key functions in the Fire Prevention Division. Examples of these responsibilities include reviewing fire protection, site, and building plans; coordinating school fire drills for the 53 public and parochial schools within the city; and to serve on several City committees and boards. The highly unique and technical skills required for this position resulted in the inability to fill the role.

To maintain this high level of service, the duties of the Fire Protection Engineer would be absorbed by both the current Civilian Fire Inspector and the Battalion Chief of Fire Prevention and Public Education. In turn, some of their duties that are pertinent to the public education discipline would be delegated to the new position. As examples, public education curriculum development, social media management, and organizing special events would become the responsibilities of the Public Education Specialist/Civilian Fire Inspector. A full listing of job functions of the new position can be found in the attached proposed position description.

This position also fills an important gap in the service delivery of the Fire Department. Our public education program currently lacks formal, age-appropriate curriculum. While the department has been able to "make do", having a dedicated public education position would ensure the highest level of quality from the program.

The budgetary impact and salary range for the new position is \$51,915.20 - \$79,372.80. The plan is to use existing budgeted funds from the Fire Protection Engineer position to fund this position. The pay range is two pay grades lower than the Fire Protection Engineer. We anticipate there will be some salary savings.

NATURE OF WORK:

This position is responsible for planning, developing, coordinating, and implementing public fire and life safety education activities and programs on behalf of the City of Appleton Fire Department. Work also involves maintaining continuous contact with area school districts, local and regional safety agencies, the general public, and assisting in information delivery to the media during major emergency incidents. The position carries a high degree of responsibility necessitating considerable technical expertise, judgement, discretion, and coordination of staff and programs. Work also involves conducting inspections to enforce all codes, laws and ordinances pertaining to fire and life safety of public buildings, events, temporary structures and places of assembly that may occur in the City. The incumbent works under the general supervision of the Battalion Chief of Fire Prevention and Public Education.

JOB FUNCTIONS:

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Plans, develops, implements, and presents diverse public fire and life safety education activities and programs which fit the needs of the citizens of Appleton and other target audiences.
- Acts as a liaison between the news media and the Fire Department for non-emergency contact
- Manages department's social media presence, including engaging citizens both proactively and responsively as necessary. Updates department website as needed.
- Assesses community educational needs and works to build community networks to target problems.
- Tracks public education activities, analyzes trends, develops and tracks outcome measures, and prepares appropriate reports.
- Displays and/or demonstrates fire safety apparatus.
- Organizes special events for the Fire Department.
- Develops lesson plans for delivery in educational settings of all levels.
- Oversees implementation of Public Education programs and provides direction and guidance to employees either directly or through chief officers.
- Maintains regular punctual and predictable attendance, works overtime and extra hours as required.
- Conducts routine and special fire inspections of public, commercial, residential, assembly, and target hazard
 occupancies, i.e. schools, day cares, hospitals, high-rises, nursing homes, care facilities, hazardous
 processing, storage, etc. ensuring compliance with local and state codes, and nationally recognized good
 practices and standards.
- Identifies corrective action that must be made to bring properties into compliance with applicable fire codes, laws, regulations, and standards.
- Conducts, supervises and documents regularly scheduled fire drills in identified occupancies.
- Works with other city/state agencies and personnel to consistently interpret and enforce fire and life safety code requirements.

OTHER JOB FUNCTIONS

- Works with the Battalion Chief of Fire Prevention and Public Education to identify budgetary needs.
- Prepares educational training programs for fire department personnel and trains them for public education activities.
- Assists in the development and delivery of technical programs related to fire code compliance and other educational activities.
- Assists in developing and implementing firefighter recruiting and mentoring strategies.
- Develops the department's annual report.
- Attends training and conferences to maintain competence in the latest educational and fire prevention practices.
- Drafts news releases and provides official statements to the media on departmental and community education activities and initiatives as required.
- Uses area demographics, NFIRS statistics and various diagnostic tools to target area needs and plan appropriate interventions.

REQUIREMENTS OF WORK:

Requires three to five years experience in developing and delivering educational programs (teacher certification preferred), some of which should be in fire prevention (or other safety or emergency response activities) and program development. A bachelor's degree is preferred; or any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides the following knowledge, skills and abilities:

- Knowledge of fire prevention methods, laws, and ordinances.
- Knowledge of teaching techniques and multimedia equipment and the ability to apply new technologies to public education activities.
- Knowledge of the policies, rules, regulations, and standard operating procedures of the Appleton Fire Department and the City of Appleton.
- Knowledge of inspection and sprinkler applications, life safety codes and city ordinances for developing programs and providing public information.
- Ability to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, with people at various levels within and outside the organization.
- Knowledge of and ability to demonstrate life saving techniques.
- Ability to keep accurate records and evaluate impact of public education programs.
- Ability to analyze program delivery and provide constructive feedback to department employees.
- Ability to develop and maintain good working relationships with news media and other agencies.
- Ability to analyze the community's public fire education needs and develop and implement appropriate programs to effectively address those needs.
- Ability to maintain knowledge of fire suppression, prevention and engineering practices.
- Ability to adapt to conflict situations that will result in a positive outcome.
- Ability to plan and schedule work so as not to cause undue budgetary impact.
- · Skill in public speaking and public relations.
- Ability to operate office equipment including but not limited to copiers, computers and software applications.

- A. On August 2, 1995, the Common Council approved Special Use Permit (SUP) #8-95, to permanently run with the Appleton Elks Lodge #337 for a "private club with a bar" located at 1103 West College Avenue. with the follow three (3) conditions (See attached report date stamped Aug 2, 1995):
 - 1. A liquor license be obtained.
 - Appleton Elks Lodge #337 held a Class B Beer/Liquor License prior to the sale of the property.
 - The Appleton Elks Lodge #337 sold the subject site to Jordan Banda pursuant to Warranty Deed Document #2230993, executed on April 16, 2021.

- 2. Joint parking easement between adjoining businesses as filed, shall be mutually recognized. Discontinuance of the joint parking agreement shall be grounds for revocation of the Special Use Permit (SUP #8-95).
 - In 1995, Appleton Elks Lodge #337 (private club with a bar) was required to have 20 off-street parking spaces on their property pursuant to the off-street parking requirements listed in City of Appleton Zoning Ordinance. The subject property was only able to accommodate 14 off-street parking spaces.
 - Condition number 2 was satisfied by a mutual joint parking agreement executed on July 11, 1995, between the Appleton Elks Lodge #377 (1103 West College Avenue) and Impact Printing (1109 West College Avenue). (See attached parking agreements)
 - The parking agreement did not specify it was transferable to other entities. Pursuant to Warranty Deed Document #2230993, executed on April 16, 2021 (noted above), the joint parking agreement between the Appleton Elks Lodge #377 (1103 West College Avenue) and Impact Printing (1109 West College Avenue) is no longer valid.
- 3. Garbage storage be interior or be located in an approved fully-enclosed outside storge area.
 - The Elks Lodge placed trash receptacles outside of the building without being fully enclosed.



Analysis:

Pursuant to the Common Council action, (SUP) #8-95 was approved to permanently run with the Appleton Elks Lodge #337 for a "private club with a bar" located at 1103 West College Avenue. As a result, SUP 8-95 *cannot be transferred to another entity or person.* Therefore, the applicants will need to apply for and receive approval of new Special Use Permit from the Common Council for a restaurant with alcohol sales at 1103 West College Avenue.

Staff Recommendation:

Based upon the above analysis, the applicants shall apply for a Special Use Permit for a restaurant with alcohol sales and consumption at 1103 West College Avenue. The Special Use Permit application materials and fee shall be submitted to the Community and Economic Development Department. The Common Council shall approve a Special Use Permit for a restaurant with alcohol sales located at 1103 West College Avenue prior to the issuance of the attached liquor license.





LTE Position 2022 (06/01/2022 – 12/31/2022)

Purpose

Traffic Safety Unit

The *Traffic Safety Unit* (TSU) will promote and facilitate the smooth and orderly flow of traffic to reduce traffic congestion, reduce the number and severity of traffic crashes, reduce motor vehicle violations within the city, and promote overall traffic safety for motorists, bicyclists, and pedestrians.

The purpose of the TSU is to protect lives and property through aggressive, proactive enforcement of motor vehicle laws and education of our community. An emphasis will be placed on enforcement of the motor vehicle laws of the State of Wisconsin and established codes by the City of Appleton.

The Appleton Police Department is committed to the strict enforcement of violations that contribute to personal injury, death, or serious property damage. These violations include, but are not limited to:

- Speed, reckless driving, or inattentive driving violations.
- · Operation of a vehicle while impaired.
- Operation of a vehicle after driving privileges have been suspended or revoked.
- All violations identified during an accident investigation.
- Pedestrian/bicycle violations that could lead to injury or death.
- Illegal equipment or operations of vehicles that create a public nuisance.

Duties and Responsibilities

Traffic Safety Officer

The following are some of the duties and responsibilities of the *Traffic Safety Officer* (TSO), these are in addition to the duties of a patrol officer:

- 1. Proactively address traffic, pedestrian, and other conveyance issues in the city and handle ongoing citizen complaints regarding traffic safety.
- 2. Aggressively enforces motor vehicle, pedestrian, and other conveyance regulations in areas of concern.
- 3. Proactively uses resources, such as speed signs and data analysis, to identify problem areas and develop mitigation strategies.
- 4. Provides community education on traffic safety, including school-related programs.
- 5. Collaborates with the CRU Lieutenant to disseminate traffic related information.
- 6. Creates programs designed to engage and educate the community on traffic safety.
- 7. Represents the department at government or community meetings related to their duties.
- 8. Is the departments point of contact for traffic-related concerns or questions.
- 9. They are not assigned in the call rotation or assigned to a district, but they will be expected to help when call volume or shift workload dictates it.
- 10. Investigating major accidents and OWI's.
- 11. Providing reports as needed that outline the performance and outcomes of the TSU.
- 12. Responsible for maintenance and certification of PBT's and Radars.
- 13. The above is not to be construed as an exhaustive statement of duties and responsibilities.

HOURS OF WORK

- 1. The pilot position will work the core hours of 3:00pm to 11:00pm, Monday to Friday, with a roll call at 2:50pm.
- 2. They would have every 4th Friday off to balance their hours to align with patrol officers.
- 3. If there are more than one Traffic Safety Officers assigned to the unit, their 4th Fridays off will be scheduled so that they are not off on the same Fridays.
- 4. The position will not supplant patrol staffing but will bolster staffing during the hours they work so they will not count towards minimum staffing. The Chief will, at their discretion, consider minimum patrol staffing levels before initially assigning an officer to the Traffic Safety Officer position.
- 5. The position will select vacation and time off separate from the normal patrol selection, approval of time off is at the discretion of their supervisor.
- 6. The position will be allowed to flex their hours during a pay period, with the permission of their supervisor, to address specific issues or perform other required duties.
- 7. The position will be filled through a selection process, with a rotation of every 2 years. Those in the position can reapply for another 2-year extension, with no limit on the number of extensions.

Patrol Usage

- The TSO will not be dispatched to handle routine calls for service, unless directed by a supervisor to assist with shift workload. They would be expected to assist with in-progress or other emergency type calls, shift supervisors will direct resources as needed.
- 2. The TSO can be assigned to investigate minor traffic crashes, when available.
- 3. The TSO should assist or investigate major traffic crashes.
- The TSO can assume OWI investigations of other officers stops, when appropriate, so district
 officers can be available for other calls.

Subject: Informational Item – Traffic Safety Unit

Our community members have identified traffic and pedestrian safety as a significant concern. In the Appleton Police Departments Community Surveys on Public Safety that were completed in 2017 and 2020, the top four issues in our city for our community members were:

- 1. Drug Abuse
- 2. Speeding and Reckless Driving
- 3. Inattentive and Distracted Driving
- 4. Operating while Under the Influence

We are all aware of the increasing problem with vehicle and pedestrian safety in all areas of our city. Our council members have been involved and interested in developing initiatives to address this issue. Additionally, Mayor Woodford has been actively engaged in these discussions and in the development of this initiative.

When the pandemic began, most communities across the country experienced a significant increase in aggressive driving behaviors. There have always been vehicle enthusiasts in our community, but there is also a cyclical life to the popularity of this hobby. During the pandemic there was a dramatic increase in both responsible enthusiasts, and irresponsible ones. As you know, this is not just a College Avenue issue, these behaviors occur across the 25 square miles of the city. From our neighborhood streets to our highways, the issues of dangerous driving and nuisance vehicles affects all of us.

Traffic safety will always be a priority for the police department, and we took additional steps to try and curb illegal behavior. We obtained additional state grant funding to bolster our enforcement efforts, made enforcement a priority for our patrol officers, and created a formal response plan for College Avenue cruising which included shutting down the avenue for vehicle traffic. Our response also included saturation patrols, when we had officers available, and asking other local police agencies to join us in high visibility policing. We also worked with organizers of planned events to try and mitigate issues, and with businesses that supply some of the equipment that is a concern.

When we have had extra officers available to focus illegal behavior, they have been extremely productive, and we believe it has sent a strong message to the community. As an example, on one Saturday night in November of 2021, we assigned officers to a traffic safety initiative and in four hours they conducted 26 traffic stops and enforced 16 loud or illegal exhaust violations.

Cruising and moving car shows have become almost weekly events in the summer, which has drained our resources as they typically occurred during our busy weekend nights. When our officers are busy dealing with traffic problems or cruising events, they are pulled out of their districts and our normal calls for service are held longer and not responded to as quickly.



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Our staff has been researching how others have been addressing this issue, not only in Wisconsin but across the country. We know we must be creative, while also being fiscally responsible, to get the biggest impact from the resources we have. We have been researching different traffic safety unit initiatives and specialty officer positions that others have implemented to determine what may be possible, and what would be the best fit for Appleton. These units and officers' sole duties are to address traffic issues and complaints, strictly enforce laws and ordinances, and work with community members and engineers to develop strategies to address areas of concern. They also make community education and promoting safe driving and pedestrian behavior one of their core duties.

With the retirement of a civilian Police Communications Specialist (front desk service) in April, we can use the salary savings from that position to fund an additional police officer position, from June 1st to the end of the year, and create a pilot program for a **Traffic Safety Unit Officer**. We will adjust the hours of our front desk to minimize the impact of the open position and adjust work schedules as needed. We estimated the cost savings for this position being left to be approximately \$52,000. We are going to use that to pay for an additional officer to work in the position of **Traffic Safety Officer** from June 1st to December 31st, 2022.

During this pilot period we will develop what a permanent program may look like and gather data on the effectiveness and productivity of the unit. The data, and feedback from the council, community members, and officers on the position, would be used to determine if we should request to continue the initiative, eliminate it, or do planning to expand the unit.

I have attached a job description to explain the purpose of the *Traffic Safety Unit* and the duties of the officer. We know this is just a framework to start with and that adjustments and changes will be necessary and should be expected.

Our message to the community: We want to grow and support a community wide commitment to improve pedestrian and traffic safety so that Appleton can continue to be a safe and amazing place for us and our families to live and play.

"Making Traffic and Pedestrian Safety a Shared Community Responsibility" will be one of the mantras of this unit.

Thank you all for your support and patience while we worked on developing this initiative.

Re: Analysis of Resolution #14-R-21

I met with ACA Glad to discuss this resolution and provide any feedback, specifically from the perspective of the Police Department. There are several points of analysis from the Police Department that I will bullet point for the committee and council.

- The resolution contains two additions to the definitions in city ordinance 12-76, which are both already covered under WI 347.39 (1) and (2): with the key terms being *modifications*, *amplify*, and excessive noise. Additionally, City Ordinance Sec. 12-81 already adopts the provisions of 347.39.
- The definitions in the proposed resolution are different than state law because the new language is specific to only "light motor vehicle" (vehicles under #8,000), while state laws apply to all motor vehicles.
- The final "be it resolved" states that infractions under the newly defined classifications be enforced consistent with policy and penalties defined under 12-76, which is the definitions section; our assumption is that the desire is for it to be enforced under 12-81 Prohibited Acts (f).

I have attached the resolution language, the applicable current WI Traffic Law, and the current ordinance that adopts the language in state law, in addition to already being adopted in our traffic code.

Intentional Vehicle Operation to Emit Excessive Noise means the operation of any intentional light motor vehicle operation in such a manner that the exhaust system emits a loud, cracking or chattering noise unusual to its normal operation with the express purpose of excessive combustion noise emissions. and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that infractions of the Noise ordinance under these newly defined classifications of intent, specifically to disrupt the peace, be enforced consistent with the policies and penalties defined under Sec 12-76

<u>Current Wisconsin Traffic Law adopted by city ordinance</u> SS.347.39 MUFFLERS

- (1) No person shall operate on a highway any motor vehicle subject to registration unless such motor vehicle is equipped with an adequate muffler in constant operation and properly maintained to prevent any excessive or unusual noise or annoying smoke. This subsection also applies to motor bicycles.
- (2) No muffler or exhaust system on any vehicle mentioned in sub. (1) shall be equipped with a cutout, bypass or similar device nor shall there be installed in the exhaust system of any such vehicle any device to ignite exhaust gases so as to produce flame within or without the exhaust system. No person shall modify the exhaust system of any such motor vehicle in a manner which will amplify or increase the noise emitted by the motor of such vehicle above that emitted by the muffler originally installed on the vehicle, and such original muffler shall comply with all the requirements of this section.
- (3) In this section, "muffler" means a device consisting of a series of chambers of baffle plates or other mechanical design for receiving exhaust gases from an internal combustion engine and which is effective in reducing noise.

WHEREAS, the City of Appleton's Municipal Code identifies noise as a serious hazard to the public health, welfare, safety and quality of life and,

WHEREAS, the people have a right to an environment free from excessive sound that may jeopardize their health, welfare, or safety, or degrade the quality of life and,

WHEREAS, Appleton Municipal Code, Sec. 12-80, states that no person shall make or cause to be made any loud, disturbing, fluctuating or unnecessary sounds or noises such as may tend to annoy or disturb a reasonable person, and Sec 12-81 (f), states that No person shall operate any motor vehicle unless such motor vehicle is equipped with an adequate muffler in constant operation and property maintained to prevent excessive or unusual noise, however, does not specify the intentional modification of vehicular exhaust systems specifically to emit excessive noise, in common vernacular "pop", "bang" or "crackle", nor does is specify certain methodologies of operator manipulation of gas flow to combustion engines to intentionally emit excessive noise, and,

WHEREAS, Section 12-76 of the Municipal Code does not have a definition of Intentional Vehicle Modifications to Emit Excessive Noise nor does not have a definition of Intentional Vehicle Operation to Emit Excessive Noise, and

WHEREAS, Health in All Policies dictates that public health and well-being drive all policy,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Appleton Code Article IV, Noise, Sec. 12-76 be amended to include the following definitions;

Intentional Vehicle Modifications to Emit Excessive Noise means any intentional after-market mechanical modifications to light motor vehicles which amplify the sound of escaping gases specifically designed to create excessive noise emissions under normal operation.


