#### RESOLUTION to add legalization advisory referendum to Fall Election Ballot

providing for an advisory referendum on the November 8, 2022, election ballot to measure public opinion on allowing adults 21 years of age and older to engage in the personal use of marijuana, while also regulating commercial marijuana-related activities, and imposing a tax on the sale of marijuana

WHEREAS, criminalizing marijuana or cannabis use has failed to curb its use and, according to a Gallup survey conducted in July 2021, 49 percent of Americans say they have used marijuana, up from 30 percent in 1985; and

WHEREAS, in a Marquette University Law School poll conducted in February 2022, 61 percent of Wisconsinites said that marijuana should be "fully legalized and regulated like alcohol", and recent polls show a majority of Americans favor legalization of adult recreational use of marijuana; and

WHEREAS, the majority of Democratic, Republican, and Independent voters favor marijuana legalization.

WHEREAS, thirty-seven states, including every state surrounding Wisconsin, have legalized some form of marijuana; and

WHEREAS, a study in late 2021 by municipal bond strategists at Barclays and reported in Fortune Magazine suggests that by 2030 states that have legalized marijuana and regulate its sale may realize \$12 billion per year in tax revenue to help balance their budgets; and

WHEREAS, Appleton is failing to benefit from marijuana-related small business opportunities and sales tax that neighboring states are increasingly capitalizing on; and

WHEREAS, marijuana use as an alternative to prescription pain killers has been shown to reduce opioid addiction, and 22% of U.S. military veterans report using medical marijuana to treat Post Traumatic Stress Disorder; and

WHEREAS, legalization would undercut the illicit market, and ensure that marijuana use and sale are regulated and safe; and

WHEREAS, the time Appleton law enforcement officers spend enforcing existing marijuana laws and ordinances negatively impacts the time they have available to solve more serious crimes and apprehend more dangerous criminals.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Common Council of Appleton, Wisconsin, request the following:

Section 1. Referendum Election. The City Clerk is hereby directed to call an advisory referendum election to be held in the City of Appleton at the regularly scheduled election to be held November 8, 2022, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of Appleton the proposition of whether the State of Wisconsin should legalize and regulate the full adult use of marijuana in Wisconsin.

Section 2. Official Referendum Ballot Form. The ballot to be used at the referendum election shall be prepared in accordance with the provisions of Sections 5.64 (2) and 7.08 (1)(a) of the Wisconsin Statutes. The ballot shall be substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Resolution #8-R-22 Advisory Referendum for Nov. 8th Election Ballot

Resolution #8-R-22 provides for adding an advisory referendum to the November election ballot. Wis. Stat. § 5.02(16s) defines "referendum" as an election at which an advisory, validating or ratifying question is submitted to the electorate." Broadly speaking, "referendum" or "referenda" are general terms that refer to a question appearing on the ballot to be voted on by voters. Direct action by a governing body that clearly establishes the referendum question is one of the ways in which a referendum arrives on the ballot. Advisory referendums are non-binding questions which survey electors to elicit their views on a question, but advisory referendums do not have the force of law. Wisconsin Statutes give no legal effect to the results of an advisory referendum, other than the weight that the governing body voluntarily assigns to the results.

The deadline for a referendum question to be approved for ballot placement for the November 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022 election is no later than August 30<sup>th</sup>.

As the proposed referendum is for a municipal advisory referendum, the cost of adding this item to the November election ballot falls on the City of Appleton. Costs related to contests on the ballot are variable in nature and dependent upon a variety of factors such as the number of other contests on the ballot, the size of the ballot, the portion taken up by the contest (referendum) on the ballot, and the total number of ballots ordered. Given that information, a rough estimate of the cost of adding this advisory referendum to the ballot for the November 8th, 2022, election is \$2,250. The exact cost of the advisory referendum will not be available until ballots are ordered, printed, and election programming is complete.



### APPLETON FIRE DEPARTMENT MID-YEAR REVIEW All figures through June 30, 2022

#### **Significant 2022 Events**

In the first quarter, the department had two captain retirements that were filled through internal promotions causing two lieutenant vacancies and subsequently, two driver/engineer vacancies. All positions were filled through internal promotions resulting in two firefighter vacancies. The department participated in the regional hiring process and hired two recruit firefighters. They started in March and have joined the ranks of the front-line operations staff after a six-week recruit academy. Department staff members have been working to improve the diversity of our applicant pool by inviting students from Fox Valley Technical College to participate in our 'ride along' program.

The Fire Protection Engineer of fifteen years also retired; however, the department was unsuccessful finding a candidate to fill that position due to the unique qualifications of the position. A change to the table of organization was proposed to add a Public Education Specialist position and remove the Fire Protection Engineer. This change will fill a gap in the service delivery of our public education efforts. The Battalion Chief of Fire Prevention and Public Education will take on plan review duties while the Public Education Specialist will be responsible for curriculum development, social media management, and organizing special events.

The Appleton Fire Department served as the host agency for a regional radio grant through the Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG). If awarded, the grant would provide intrinsically safe portable radio components for eighteen fire and EMS agencies in Outagamie County. As host agency, the department gathered information from all participating agencies and completed the grant application. The grant awards have not been announced, however, are expected in the coming months.

In addition to the regional AFG grant, the department applied for an Assistance to Firefighter's Grant that would provide paramedic training for six Appleton Fire Department personnel. Preliminary work has been completed with the Human Resources Department and bargaining unit to address the class schedule and work rules should the grant be awarded. Participation in this grant is another step toward a higher level of emergency medical service by having paramedic engine companies.

The Resource Development and Special Operations Division collaborated with area fire departments to bring in the nationally recognized speaker and author, Captain Michael Abrashoff, to speak to department leaders and area businesses. In addition, the department hosted an incident safety officer class for both our personnel and area fire department personnel. A confined space class was provided resulting in 20 additional members qualified as confined space technicians. A ropes class was offered bringing all personnel to the operations level for ropes. Fourteen members participate in a hazardous materials drill

with our partners in Manitowoc. Out-of-state training opportunities that fire department personnel participated in included a hazardous materials meter repair class, a hazardous materials conference, and the Fire Department Instructor's Conference.

The Appleton Fire Department, along with other agencies, worked with Wisconsin Emergency Management (WEM) to develop a contract for the Wisconsin Task Force 1 (WI-TF1). WI-TF1 had been dormant for a few years until efforts to bring it back to an operational status were pursued. The task force is expected to be fully operational by midyear. Department personnel can attend advanced level rescue operations training otherwise not available. Knowledge and skills learned during these training opportunities are brought back and shared with the remainder of the department improving our ability to respond to these types of incidents locally.

Fire department personnel along with Facilities staff have had preliminary meetings with an architectural firm to develop plans for the newly constructed Fire Station # Four based on a programming discussion and space needs analysis. An emphasis is being placed on 'interior response time' with main access corridors allowing ease of flow from the station spaces to the truck floor.

On May 15, 2022, the department recognized the three-year anniversary of the line-of-duty death of Driver/Engineer Mitchell Lundgaard. The plans for Lundgaard Park continue to move forward with the development of a concept plan. This vision will be utilized as the city works toward a \$3 million fundraising goal with the Friends of the Appleton Fire Department. It is hopeful that a final design and construction will occur in the next one to two years. Representatives from the Appleton Fire Department, the Lundgaard family, and City staff continue to be involved with this project.

In May, the department ordered a new fire engine prior to a material price increase. In addition, the city was able to realize cost savings by taking advantage of a pre-payment option. Unfortunately, the delivery of the new firetruck is approximately two years so late 2023 or early 2024.

In 2021, the fire chiefs from the Appleton, Grand Chute, Kaukauna, Neenah-Menasha, and Oshkosh Fire Departments approached the Wisconsin Policy Forum to request a report on working together to promote greater efficiency and teamwork enhanced by an existing strong cooperative spirit. It is believed that our departments could benefit further from enhanced collaboration in the areas of training, special operations, community risk reduction, fleet maintenance, and EMS quality control and oversight. The Wisconsin Policy Forum is the state's leading source of nonpartisan, independent research on state and local public policy. They produce reports that help generate informed and fact-based public policy decision making. They released a report responding to our request and suggested options for enhanced collaborations between the departments. Within each functional area, they presented options that would allow departments to "start small" and potentially build over time toward more comprehensive collaborations.

With rising costs related to personal protective equipment (PPE), the department evaluated its replacement practice for protective clothing and will be closely scrutinizing replacement PPE when employee retirement is within a five-year timeframe. This adjustment to current practice will help absorb the rising costs passed down from suppliers in the coming years.

The current bargaining agreement with Local 257 is in effect through December 31, 2022. City staff from the fire department and Human Resources are beginning negotiation preparation of the next bargaining agreement. Formal meetings will begin in July.

#### **ADMINISTRATION**

#### **Objectives**

- Identifying currently provided service levels and evaluating their effectiveness and customer value.
- Addressing service needs created by continued City growth.
- Maintaining staffing levels as detailed in the table of organization and approved by the Common Council.
- Continuing the development of joint service opportunities and regional relationships with neighboring fire departments.
- Enhancing internal and external communications and working relationships.
- Continuing to implement the records management system (RMS) for improved reporting capabilities.

#### FIRE SUPPRESSION

#### **Objectives**

- Identify and develop pre-fire plans for new structures and update pre-fire plans for existing structures, and develop emergency response plans for special events which present potential risks within the community
- Proactively pursuing, with our regional partners, the enhancement of our current mutual aid
  agreements and automatic aid agreements, evaluation of shared resources, updating of emergency
  management planning, and cooperative training exercises to help reduce the threats to our regional
  security and economy.
- Identifying and developing employee safety programs, practices, and training for reducing the impact of lost time work-related injuries.

#### **SPECIAL OPERATIONS**

#### **Objectives**

- Providing for local hazardous materials response in jurisdictions as defined by contract.
- Seeking grant opportunities for equipment and training available through local and state organizations.
- Maintaining necessary equipment and skill levels for local incidents.
- Participating on the county Local Emergency Planning Committee.
- Continuing the partnership with Winnebago County (Oshkosh Fire Department) and Brown County (Green Bay Metro Department).
- Providing specialized emergency response to include local hazardous materials response, confined space rescue, water rescue, structural collapse response, and trench rescue

#### RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT

#### **Objectives**

- Maintain compliance with federal and State mandatory class requirements
- Investigate and encourage attendance at specialized training to expand personal growth and development
- Facilitate and coordinate the Safety Committee meetings for the Department to promote health and safety among the department employees
- Seek opportunities to provide leadership training, including command level training, through internal and/or external sources
- Continuing to define our role as fire and EMS providers at active shooter incidents.

#### **EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**

#### **Objectives**

- To provide timely, state of the art pre-hospital care to all people within our service area that are subject to illness or injury
- To provide quality, consistent pre-hospital medical training to all employees of the Fire Department resulting in all employees being certified at the Emergency Medical Technician Basic level
- To maintain compliance with department, local and State codes, laws, guidelines, and regulations
- To ensure continuous program development and quality improvement
- Working with our Medical Director, monitor the percentage of cardiac patients who were discovered in ventricular fibrillation that survived and were discharged from the hospital

- Continue working with our automatic aid partners--the Town of Grand Chute and the Cities of Neenah and Menasha.


#### Total Calls for Service



# LEGAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT MID-YEAR REVIEW

All figures through June 30, 2022

#### Significant 2022 Events:

The Legal Services Department has been engaged in a number of matters through the first half of 2022. Below are some of the highlights for the first half of the year:

#### City Attorney's Office

- As of April 29, represented the City in traffic and ordinance related matters in 2022 including 1,875 scheduled initial court appearances, 59 scheduled jury and court trials and 767 scheduled pre-trials/jury trial conferences or motion hearings.
- Provided guidance and training to the newly-seated Council and completed a significant revision to the Alderperson Handbook.
- Actively engaged in litigation including defense of a variety of lawsuits including, but not limited to, employment matters, land use, property damage, foreclosures, and small claims.
- Worked with the Department of Public Works on two eminent domain processes to acquire the necessary land for future roadway and a second raw water line (PLE).
- Provided ongoing assistance in various roles in support of the Library building project.
- Drafted or assisted in amending or creating a number of ordinances, including redistricting, parking, a stormwater ordinance rewrite and changes to the solid waste ordinances in Chapter 15.
- Legal Services represented the Complainant and separately advised the Safety and Licensing Committee in the revocation of a tavern's alcohol license.
- In the first six months of 2022, the Attorney's Office has processed over 250 new agreements/contracts. Processing a contract includes the preparation of the contract document, circulation for signatures, tracking, and distribution.

#### **City Clerk's Office:**

- Performed an operational analysis of electronic poll book equipment to detect necessary hardware upgrades/repairs
- Responded to a considerable number of extensive records requests related to elections.
- Restructured the filing system in the vault to make them more identifiable and accessible.
- Digitized files to increase accessibility of records and documents.
- Drafted and mailed letters to all properties affected by Redistricting.
- Worked with the Counties and State to make Ward and Aldermanic boundary adjustments to accommodate new legislative district changes as a result of a court ruling modifying the previously adopted districts.
- Implemented all redistricting changes through election plan modifications in WisVote.
- Revised the alcohol license demerit point tracking and notification process.

#### **Areas of Primary Concentration for the remainder of 2022:**

- We will continue working with other departments in the City to ensure that City projects run smoothly and there is no delay in project completions.
- The City Attorney's Office will continue to vigorously defend the City of Appleton in actions filed against the City of Appleton.
- We will continue to assist, guide and advise City staff from all departments as well as elected officials on legal matters in a timely fashion.
- The City Clerk's Office will administer 2 more elections, including a General Election with a voter turnout that is anticipated to be very high.
- The City Clerk's Office will continue to process and send a significant number of absentee ballots for each upcoming election.
- The City Clerk's Office will recruit and train additional election workers to administer the busy November Election.
- The City Clerk's Office will continue streamlining and organizing all City records to enhance accessibility to City documents.




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
#### Absentee Ballots




#### Percent of Absentee Ballots Returned




#### Ballots Cast and Registered Voters\*





**Subject:** Significant incidents at Speakeasy Bar, 425 W College Ave.

In the past six months we have seen an increase in calls for service at the *Speakeasy Bar* at 425 W. College Ave. The data indicates that this increase is mainly due to fights in and around the establishment. The data, confirmed by the observations of our officers and supervisors, is that many of these incidents are large or multiple physical fights occurring at the same time, resulting in significant injuries. We have worked with the owner of Speakeasy, Ted Suess, but we are still seeing a higher number of more significant issues at the establishment.

There have been five (5) fights involving patrons reported to the APD in or outside of the front doors of Speakeasy that have resulted in several physical arrests or citations in the last six months. There is another bar on College Ave. that has had more calls for service during this time frame, but with less serious types of calls, that is currently being addressed. As a comparison to the five (5) calls at Speakeasy, the bar with the next closest number of calls had two (2) disturbances and needed little police intervention. An APD Lieutenant who arrived on scene to one of the fights at Speakeasy on 07/02/22 observed approximately five different fights occurring at the same time. The traffic camera footage from this incident shows a very dangerous and chaotic scene.

It is clear that the most dangerous incidents happen on nights they host a performer or special event. We do not have incidents on every one of these nights, however, they clearly increase the frequency and significance of the problem. As an example, there is an event being promoted called a "Trap House Party", scheduled for July 23, 2022. If you are not aware of it, dictionary.com defines "Trap House" as a place where illicit drugs are bought, sold, or used. This event features a musician who is seen in a recently released music video displaying multiple guns, and the last time this entertainer performed at Speakeasy we had significant disturbances.

We have worked with the establishment to try and assist them in resolving some of the issues..

• Capt. Frisch, ACA Nicholas VandeCastle and I met with Ted Suess and his bar manager after a large fight in front of Speakeasy on 04/10/22. We suggested increasing bar staff, closing the bar earlier and having bouncers assist with clearing patrons from the front of the bar after bar close.

- Mr. Suess took those suggestions and it appeared to help with some of the issues. On some occasions officers complimented his staff for the extra work they put in.
- Another fight occurred in Speakeasy on 05/29/22. During this fight a patron was hit in the head with a glass. This fight was handled by officers and two different people were cited. I met with Mr. Suess after this incident and continued to provide suggestions for more staff when they are hosting events. Mr. Suess was responsive to these requests.
- We had another fight on 06/11/22 that resulted in criminal charges, another large disturbance on 06/25/22, and a large fight involving multiple groups of people on 07/02/22. Officers have also observed the back door of the business being open and multiple people coming in and out of it.
- On the weekend of 07/09/22 officers observed that Speakeasy had closed the blinds on the front of the business. I spoke to Mr. Suess on 07/19/22 and expressed my concerns. Mr. Suess was unaware that the back door was being used by patrons. He was aware of the manager and other performers using the door. When asked about the blinds being closed, he stated that they closed them due to hosting a Lingerie Party

The Appleton Police Department has made several attempts to address on-going safety concerns. The safety of anyone patronizing this establishment or visiting our downtown entertainment district is our priority. The number of issues we have seen around Speakeasy is not acceptable and we are concerned for the patrons, citizens, and our officers' safety if these incidents continue. The information provided to the Safety and Licensing committee is informational at this time. It is important for this committee to hear these concerns. All videos, still images and documents can be shared with any member of the committee. Please reach out to me with any other questions or concerns.
