We'll begin moving forward if approved by Council with the DOT on selecting a design consultant. And as part of that design process, the truck route analysis, as submitted by resolution, will be

considered at that time. It's probably one of the first questions that will need to be answered in order to keep moving forward with the Lawe Street design.
