Thank you. It's actually the anticipated end date for the need based on the demolition and the construction operations that are being conducted there. If they would go beyond that date, we would begin to have discussions much earlier than December 31 so we could have the permit extended or brought back through committee. Also, we'd have to have a conversation with our finance department related to the drive-up window along that alley, as we move into January, still another busy time for finance. So, we'd have to coordinate those dates as well. And we've had discussions about this, and we're comfortable with December 31, but knowing that construction delays, weather delays, and just contractor delays could cause that to change.

Do we know approximately how much extra time we have built into this in the hopes that it will be finished before the—well around the end of the year for our finance department to use that window?

So, the Finance Department window closures are spelled out within the permit application. So, whether or not they end up needing all the way to December 31, we're clear on when Finance needs that window. If they were to end early, the closure would be pulled back and, you know, the—this would not be needed anymore. So.
