Thank you. At Safety and Licensing committee there was a question about the hours for the street occupancy permit, which is required for this premises amendment. So after verifying those hours, that street occupancy permit policy allows the tables and chairs and service to be until 9:30pm, and on the premises amendment form, 10pm is listed. So I just want to make it clear or known for the record that the premises amendment would comply with that policy to have the service end at 9:30pm.
