And I wonder if there are additional spaces that could be named later, and what the right process would be to handle a donation or request to name something six months from now.

Sure, you're right. The existing policy is specifically for the capital campaign. So, when the capital campaign closes, should the Friends and the trustees want to pursue other forms of recognition or honor in terms of naming within the building, say, extending the stacks for support initiative, or there are some spaces that were available that were not selected for naming. So, if there was a process determined for, say, major gifts to the endowment or something like that, that that could be developed for sure.
