Award Recommendation for a Valley Transit Support Vehicle Re:

#### **BACKGROUND**

In conducting Valley Transit services throughout the Fox Cities, staff is required to provide support services on a daily basis. Examples include maintaining bus facilities, shelters and bus stops.

It is necessary to purchase a maintenance support vehicle at this time.

Valley transit budgeted sufficient funds for a support vehicle.

#### **ANALYSIS**

The State of Wisconsin DOA, Division of Enterprise Operations, State of Bureau of Procurement successfully completed a solicitation that was competitively bid and designated as a cooperative purchasing contract, allowing municipalities to use this purchasing contract.

Bids meeting the minimum requirements delineated above were received by the State contract. Low to High bids were received for similar vehicles.

#### FISCAL IMPACT

Valley Transit budgeted sufficient funds for a support vehicle in the 2025 budget. Napleton Chevrolet Columbus, 800 Maple Ave., Columbus, WI 53925 submitted the lowest bid at \$64,649.50. The cost will be distributed between a FTA grant 80% (\$51,719.6) and Local 20% (12,929.90).

Valley Transit has sufficient fund balances within the budget.

#### RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends authorization for Valley Transit to issue a Purchase Order to Napleton Chevrolet for a Diesel (Fleet) 2025 Chevrolet Silverado 2500HD 4WD work truck for \$64,649.50.

**RE:** Award Recommendation for Northern Winnebago Dial A Ride Service Contract

In addition to fixed-route bus service, Valley Transit offers a demand responsive ambulatory transportation service for elderly residents of the Cities of Neenah and Menasha, the Village of Fox Crossing, and a portion of Winnebago County within the City of Appleton (Heritage Area). The service is called Northern Winnebago Dial A Ride (NWDAR) and is currently provided by contract with Running Inc. The current agreement expires on June 30, 2025.

In preparation for this procurement, Valley Transit staff developed a request for proposal (RFP) to select a contractor to provide this service. Staff considered lessons learned, competencies required by the next contractor, and incorporated these areas into the RFP.

The NWDAR RFP listed the contract length at four years commencing on July 1, 2025, with options to extend for three additional one-year periods.

The RFP document was sent directly to known paratransit vendors, posted on Valley Transit's website and posted on the State of Wisconsin's VendorNet system. Proposals were due on February 21, 2025.

Two proposals were received: Running Inc (Viroqua, WI) and LIR Transportation LLC (Appleton, WI). All proposals were considered 'responsive' by meeting the mandatory requirements listed in the RFP.

#### **ANALYSIS**

An evaluation team was assembled to review the proposals. In summary, the evaluation committee agreed that Running Inc. proposed adequate staffing to provide the service at all service hours required; a compliant maintenance program; a compliant drug & alcohol testing program; a good understanding of customer service and safety; proper staff training; and sufficient vehicles to operate the service. Running Inc. also has access to Valley Transit's scheduling and reporting software that

provides for improved oversight of the contract. The evaluation team determined that Running Inc. was the only vendor who could meet Valley Transit's requirements.

Valley Transit's 2025 proposed operating budget includes adequate funding for the NWDAR service contract. The local share of this service is paid by The City of Neenah, the Village of Fox Crossing and Winnebago County.

**RE:** Award Recommendation for Outagamie County Rural Service Contract

In addition to fixed-route bus service, Valley Transit offers a demand responsive rural transportation service for elderly and disabled passengers in the non-urbanized areas of Outagamie County. The service is called Outagamie County Rural Service (OC Rural) and is currently provided by contract with Running Inc. The current agreement expires on June 30, 2025.

In preparation for this procurement, Valley Transit staff developed a request for proposal (RFP) to select a contractor to provide this service. Staff considered lessons learned, competencies required by the next contractor, and incorporated these areas into the RFP.

The Outagamie County Rural RFP listed the contract length at four years commencing on July 1, 2025, with options to extend for three additional one-year periods.

The RFP document was sent directly to known paratransit vendors, posted on Valley Transit's website and posted on the State of Wisconsin's VendorNet system. Proposals were due on February 21, 2025.

Two proposals were received: Running Inc (Viroqua, WI) and LIR Transportation LLC (Appleton, WI). All proposals were considered 'responsive' by meeting the mandatory requirements listed in the RFP.

#### **ANALYSIS**

An evaluation team was assembled to review the proposals. Each proposal was evaluated based on experience, professional competence, technical approach, understanding and completeness of proposal, capacity & price. The team discussed perceived benefits of both proposals. After considering the written proposals the evaluation team unanimously concluded that Running Inc (Viroqua, WI) had proposed the best service for Valley Transit.

Running Inc. was considered responsible based on previous contract performance and references. #### **BACKGROUND**

Valley Transit utilizes a contractor, STAR Protection & Patrol, to provide a security officer at the downtown Appleton Transit Center and adjacent areas. The current agreement with Star Protection and Patrol ends June 30, 2025.

In preparation for this procurement, Valley Transit staff developed a request for proposal (RFP) to select a contractor to provide this service. Staff considered lessons learned, competencies required by the next contractor, and incorporated these areas into the RFP.

The RFP document was sent directly to known vendors; posted on Valley Transit's website and posted on the State of Wisconsin's Vendornet system. Proposals were due on February 21, 2025. Two proposals were received: STAR Protection & Patrol (Oshkosh, WI); and Total Security & Safety (Oshkosh, WI).

Both proposals met the mandatory requirements and moved forward in the evaluation process.

#### **ANALYSIS**

An evaluation team was assembled to review the written proposals and costs. Each proposal was evaluated based on the vendor's experience/qualifications, standard post orders & policies, training and cost.

After considering all factors, the evaluation team unanimously concluded that STAR Protection & Patrol (Oshkosh, WI) had proposed the best service and value for Valley Transit.

STAR Protection & Patrol had experience providing security officers at the transit center as the incumbent over the past several years. The City of Appleton Police Department has a working relationship with STAR Protection & Patrol due to their interaction at the transit center and other city events. STAR Protection & Patrol's proposal was well-organized and included a clear training program with continuing training annually for officers. STAR Protection & Patrol proposed daily supervisor contact and weekly site visits of assigned officers.

The Total Security & Safety proposal was considered not responsive to the main written portion of the RFP as it did not address many required questions.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

Valley Transit's 2025 budget includes adequate funding for contracted security service. The project will have a total year-one fiscal impact of approximately \$96,000, which is the current budget.

STAR Protection & Patrol's cost proposal includes an annual increase of approximately 5% to their cost per hour in years 2-4 of the contract.

#### **RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends authorization for Valley Transit to enter into a 4-year contract with three 1-year optional extensions with STAR Protection & Patrol to provide security services.

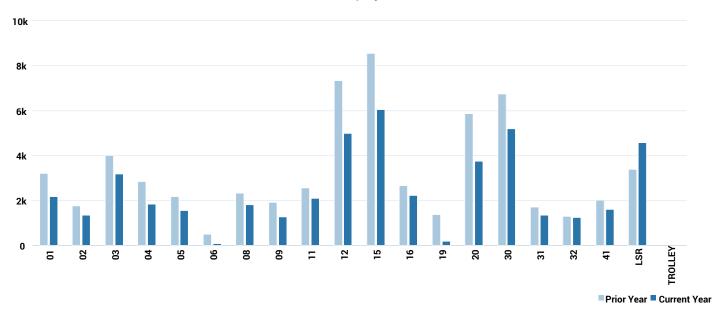

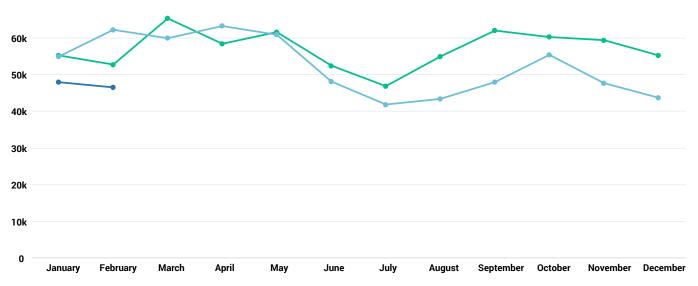

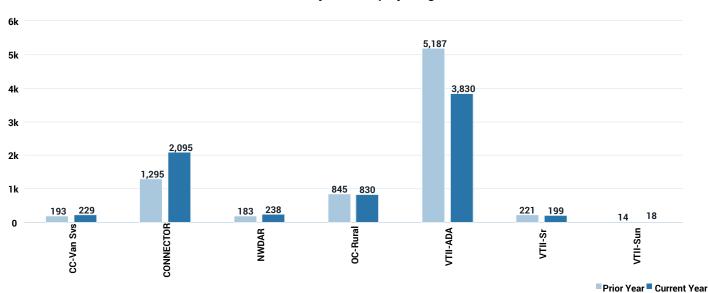
