They are dispensing alcohol to a minor which carries an 80-point demerit, and all three establishments have received that 80-point demerit and they have an 80-point total as of this meeting.

What—for those in the audience, what we ask establishments to do when they have a demerit point violation is come before this committee and explain measures that they're taking to learn from what happened and what they're going to prevent it from happening into the future. And your name for the record? Okay. Thank you. Go ahead.

[The microphone is not turned on when he first started speaking] ...installing the scanner that is scans the ID, and we we—in the POS itself, so we have set up in a way that, like, the when they are making the sale of the alcohol, they have to manually enter check the ID. If they if they are checking the ID, it should scan. If it doesn't scan, then they have to manually enter the valid date of birth. We have started doing that one. So, we have started doing the internal compliance. You know, that way, like we would randomly go to the store, send the minor just to make sure they are complying with the—they are looking at the ID and doing the compliance check. And we have started implementing the general tolerance policy that way. Like if they are selling to the minor, there is no any way other than the termination of the employee.

And so those are the three policy there that we think that would reduce the violation and we want to be—we don't want to make any more violation in future.
