OFFICE RUDEBECK REPORTING:

On 09-14-2024 I, Officer Rudebeck #9193, was assigned to the College Avenue detail from 2200-0300 hours. I was in full uniform and in squad 928.

At approximately 0112 hours, I had heard officers report that there was a disturbance in the alley behind Mr. Frogs located at 409 W College Ave, City of Appleton, Outagamie County, WI 54911. Upon arrival, I noticed there was a larger crowd in the parking lot of St. Joseph Catholic Church, located at 404 W Lawrence St, City of Appleton, Outagamie County, WI 54911.

I had observed several occupants yelling and appeared to have been in some sort of disturbance. While looking through the parking lot, I noticed a Hispanic male crouched between several cars and had his shirt off. Based on training and experience, I believed that the male was involved in a physical disturbance. When he proceeded to try and hide in between parked vehicles, I called out to him and blipped him with flashlight and had told him to stop. The male looked at me and began to run southbound through the parking lot. I announced myself as a police officer and again told him to stop. The male continued to run southbound and was later brought to the ground by Ofc. Biffert #9139. The male was later placed into handcuffs that were properly fitted and escorted to Ofc. Biffert's squad. For more information, please see Ofc. Biffert's supplemental report and other supplements.

The male at first claimed he did not have an ID and verbally identified himself as Manuel A Cerda with a DOB of 01-31-2000. A WI driver's license was later located on his person with a name of [REDACTED]. Based on physical features, I did not believe the ID belonged to him. While officers were searching Manuel, I had overheard that he admitted that he had marijuana on his person. For more information, please see the supplemental reports. Ofc. Biffert later transported Manuel to Outagamie County Jail, and I ended contact with him.

Supplemental Narrative

On 09/15/2024 at approximately 0111 hrs. I, Officer Biffert #9139 heard officers report a physical fight between a large group of individuals at Mr. Frogs 409 W College Av. Appleton, WI 54911. I heard additional units being requested to the south alley behind the business.

Upon arrival, I noticed multiple people in the St. Joseph Parish parking lot. I then parked my squad at the intersection of Walnut St. and Lawrence St. with my emergency lights activated. While exiting my squad, I heard officers yell "Police Stop" towards a male that was running south through the parking lot not wearing a shirt. It should be noted that at this time, I was driving marked squad 1041 and wearing my full police uniform. After noticing the male running full speed towards me, I grabbed onto the male and lowered him to the ground using my weight. The male was later identified as Manuel Cerda. Manuel was subsequently placed in handcuffs while on the ground. I asked Manuel if he was injured and if he needed medical attention. Manuel stated no.

Manuel was asked prior to searching if he had anything illegal on him. Manuel admitted that he had some weed in his pocket. I located a package of "Strawberry Cannabis". According to the package the bag contained 7g of Cannabis flower. The package was located in Manuel's front pants pocket. I also located a WI DL belonging to [REDACTED] in Manuel's front pants pocket. At this time, Manuel gave officers a different name and officers were not able to positively identify him. Manuel was transported to the Outagamie County jail where Grand Chute Police was able to confirm identity using live scan that his name was Manuel Cerda. I issued a citation to Manuel for underage drinking/posses as Manuel was 19 years old and admitted to being on "the liquor" and

showed signs of intoxication and impairment. The citation was given to Manuel and the mandatory court appearance was explained. Manual was then released to jail staff.

I tested the green bud like substance inside the package and the substance tested positive for THC using a Mobile Detect pouch. The package was then inventoried at the Appleton Police Department. I also inventoried the WI DL for [REDACTED] for safekeeping.

LIEUTENANT BOTZ REPORTING:

On 09/15/2024 I was working as a fully uniformed Patrol Lieutenant for the Appleton Police Department. While working in this capacity, I was conducting foot patrol in the 400 block of West College Avenue.

While in the area, I observed music stop playing within Mr. Frogs located at 409 West College Avenue. I immediately found it strange the music had stopped playing as I was aware the bar was currently full of bar patrons and it was not yet close to mandatory bar close. It has been my experience that when bar music suddenly stops playing with a large amount of patrons still inside the bar, it is likely due to a disturbance occurring within the confines of the bar.

When I made my way into the bar, I noticed the main dance floor primarily empty and a large group of people actively yelling and moving towards a back patio door that lead into Kimball Alley. I radioed to other Police Units of the disturbance and the need for additional resources.

When I got into the alley, I noticed the same group continuing to engage in disruptive behavior. I observed several people physically fighting with each other and other people with their shirts off yelling. In total, there was approximately 10-20 people engaged in this disruptive behavior.

I verbalized to the group, Police stop! A majority of the group immediately began running away from me and my current position. At this time, I saw other Officers begin to arrive in the area and was aware of one individual who was detained that was seen running from this immediate area.

At this point, I had no further involvement in this incident.
