Original Narrative

09/22/2024 13:36:57

On 9/21/24 at approximately 1235hrs, I was dispatched to make a telephone call to [REDACTED] in reference to a disturbance that had occurred at Mr. Frog's, located at 403 W College Ave, between 0100-0200hrs.

Upon telephone contact, [REDACTED] advised that she had been having problems with a Deondra Lohrentz-Pamonicutt for several months. Earlier this morning, she had been at Mr. Frog's. After using the restroom, [REDACTED] was walking back into the bar area. [REDACTED] stated that Deondra came up from behind her and punched her in the cheek and traveling to her eye. Security initially broke up the fight, but when Deondra got away from security, [REDACTED] told me that she began fighting Deondra.

I asked [REDACTED] what she meant but she began fighting, and she told me that she punched Deondra at least twice to defend herself. [REDACTED] told me that she now had a black eye and possibly a broken finger. [REDACTED] had not gone to a doctor and did not plan to as she had already placed a splint on the finger.

I asked [REDACTED] if she would be willing to meet me at APD so I could observe her injuries, and she agreed. At approximately 1340hrs, [REDACTED] arrived at APD. I spoke to [REDACTED] in lobby conference room A. I immediately noticed [REDACTED] left eye was black.

I asked [REDACTED] how she knew Deondra, and she stated they had been roommates from January of 2024 to March of 2024 but things didn't work out. Deondra also believes that [REDACTED] owes her money for a security deposit which has caused Deondra to harass [REDACTED] for the last few months.

[REDACTED] stated that when she was at Mr. Frog's earlier in the morning, she did not know that Deondra was there. [REDACTED] stated that it wasn't until Deondra hit her in the face that she knew she was there. [REDACTED] denied any in person or electronic communication leading up to the disturbance. [REDACTED] advised that getting punched in the face caused her pain without consent.

I asked [REDACTED] how her finger got injured, and she stated it was from her punching Deondra in the face twice. [REDACTED] also did not recall if she punched Deondra before or after security broke the two of them up. Security removed Deondra from the bar and [REDACTED] was allowed to remain. Security had also told [REDACTED] that there would be surveillance video of the incident.

I provided [REDACTED] a VC information sheet and ended my contact with her. I also went over the no contact provision with [REDACTED] in the event that Deondra was located and taken into custody. The no contact will be in effect if Deondra is taken into custody.

On 9/22/24 at approximately 0930hrs, I called Deondra with no answer. I left Deondra a message to call me back at APD.

At the time of this report, Deondra has not contacted me. This case will be active pending contact with Deondra.

On 9/26/24 at approximately 1120hrs, Deondra arrived at APD to speak with me. I was handling another call for service and was unable to speak to Deondra. I requested Sgt. Hoffman complete the interview for me.

Sgt. Hoffman contacted me via telephone and briefed me on the interview. Based upon the interview, I requested Sgt. Hoffman take Deondra into custody for domestic battery and DC. Sgt. Hoffman confined Deondra at OCJ on those charges and provided her with the 72hr no contact provision.

At approximately 1350hrs, I completed a follow up phone call with ██████ Sgt. Hoffman had relayed to me that ██████ had been intentionally bumping into Deondra and her friends at the bar. I asked ██████ about this, and she maintained her original story that she did not know Deondra was at the bar and was blindsided by Deondra when she left the restroom.

I requested night shift officers attempt to obtain video from the bar. However, at the time of this report, they have been unable to obtain the video. I will continue to attempt to make contact with the bar to obtain video footage. Harbor House was notified of the domestic arrest. ██████ opts IN to sharing information with Harbor House and VCRs.

On 09/26/2024 I Sgt Hoffman with the Appleton Police Department's Special Investigations Unit, was contacted by Sgt. Schneider. Sgt. Schneider stated he was investigating a disturbance that occurred the weekend before. He already spoke with one of the parties involved and the other party agreed to come into the lobby for an interview. I then responded to the Appleton Police Department lobby where I made contact with Deondra R. Lohrentz Panonicutt.

I spoke with Deondra in an interview room. I informed her that I was assisting Sgt. Schneider with his investigation into a disturbance that happened the previous weekend. Initially Deondra stated that she was not going to say anything because she did not want to incriminate herself. I informed her that I know there are two sides to every story and it was important that we hear her side of it. She indicated that she did not have anything to say. I then informed her that if that was the case I would only have one side of the story to go on and that she would be placed under arrest for battery. Deondra asked if she decided to talk to me, if she would still be arrested. I told her that it depended on the information she provided. She then agreed to speak with me. I explained to Deondra that she was not required to speak with me if she did not want to. Her statement would be

voluntary.

Deondra stated that she and [REDACTED], who was the other party involved in the disturbance, had been roommates for three months. She stated that they lived together in Green Bay. Deondra decided to move out prior to the lease agreement and there was a dispute over getting money back for the security deposit. Deondra stated that [REDACTED] owed her the money but refused to pay her.

Deondra stated that she and a group of friends went out to the bars together the night of the incident. They were at several other establishments prior to the fight. She indicated that she and [REDACTED] had several friends in common. Throughout the night she would see [REDACTED] around her group of friends. Deondra indicated that [REDACTED] would bump into her and her friends while walking through the bar.

Later in the evening they ended up at Mr. Frogs. While they were standing at the bar, [REDACTED] walked up and bumped into her again. At that point, Deondra stated that she turned around and shoved [REDACTED] [REDACTED] backed up like she did not want to fight. When Deondra turned around and faced away from her, [REDACTED] grabbed her by the hair and struck her in the face. That is when the fight ensued. Deondra stated that workers at the bar broke them up and told them to leave. She ended up leaving the bar after that. I asked if she suffered any injuries and she stated that she had a bruise on her left eyebrow. I looked, but could not observe any injury. It should be noted that Deondra did have make up on that could have concealed the injury. I asked Deondra where in the bar the fight occurred and she stated that it happened by the bar area.

I then contacted Sgt. Schneider and informed him of Deondra's statement. He stated that based on his investigation he wanted Deondra taken into custody for misdemeanor battery. I then informed Deondra that she would be taken into custody for the battery. She was walked to the Outagamie County jail. Deondra indicated that she had the money to post bond. She was handcuffed prior to walking into the jail. I had Deondra read and sign the 72 hour no contact form due to it being a domestic related arrest. She was then turned over to the Outagamie County Jail staff. A copy of the 72 hour no contact was provided to Deondra, the jail, and Sgt. Schneider.
