Officer Ballweg Reporting #9167

On September 22nd, 2024, around 0218 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I operated an unmarked APD patrol car with the identification number #926. I was on foot in the 400 block of W College Ave, Appleton, WI 54911, Outagamie County. I observed a large crowd gathering in front of 409 W College Ave, Mr. Frogs. I then saw two females on the ground in front of the establishment. I informed Dispatch that there was an active disturbance and approached the disturbance.

I saw two females on the ground and a third female attempting to break up the fight. I announced "Police" and told both parties to end the fight. The female, later identified as [REDACTED] [REDACTED] ceased fighting. The other female, identified as Izarian Lo, continued to hold onto [REDACTED] hair and was actively pulling it. I grabbed onto Izarian's hands in an attempt to make her let go of [REDACTED]. I felt Izarian tense her muscles in her arm and pull, which caused a large chunk of [REDACTED] hair to be pulled out. I then started to pull Izarian away from [REDACTED] and saw Izarian kick at [REDACTED] as I was pulling her away. [REDACTED] did not attempt to reengage.

I continued to pull Izarian away from [REDACTED]. Izarian stated "I will do it again,

take me to jail. It was fucking worth it." I secured Izarian in handcuffs and started to have her sit up. As I did that, she informed me that she would do it again. I took "it" to be fighting [REDACTED] Izarian was walked to Officer Jakobsen's squad and I informed her that she was under arrest. A person that Izarian seemed to know walked up to us and Izarian again stated "I'll do it again, it was worth it, it was worth it." Izarian also informed me that [REDACTED] had started the disturbance by swinging at her first. Izarian was secured in a squad car and buckled.

I then walked over to where [REDACTED] was speaking with Officer VanDinter #9148. [REDACTED] informed him that Izarian had ripped some of her hair out and just walked up to [REDACTED] and started to attack her. [REDACTED] explained that [REDACTED] brother and Izarian had a falling out, which led to issues between [REDACTED] and Izarian. [REDACTED] friend, [REDACTED] confirmed what [REDACTED] was saying. [REDACTED] felt pain from Izarian kicking and pulling her hair. [REDACTED] did not give consent for Izarian to hit her, kick her or pull her hair. [REDACTED] was provided a victim packet and opted into services. [REDACTED] was then released from the scene. See Officer Vandinter's supplement for further.

I had Officer Jakobsen transported Izarian to the Outagamie County jail. She would be confined on battery and disorderly conduct, due to her actions on the avenue. Izarian informed me of the following information unprompted. [REDACTED] had attacked her first earlier in the night and punched her in the eye. Later when they saw each other again Izarian approached [REDACTED] and told her to "do it again." Izarian explained that she reapproached [REDACTED] because if Izarian just walked away after being punched, she would have been made fun of on social media. [REDACTED] did appear to have a watery and red left eye but had also started to cry as soon as she was placed in the back of the squad car. She was unable to tell me where on the avenue [REDACTED] had punched her. [REDACTED] also continued to make several statements about how she would fight [REDACTED] again, but did not think it was fair that she was the one going to jail. Izarian was confined without incident.

I viewed the Avigilon cameras for the intersection of W College Ave and N Division St. It clearly showed the disturbance. At 0217 hours, Izarian can be seen standing in front of Sal's Pizza to the west of Mr. Frogs. Izarian appears to be looking toward Mr. Frogs, where [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] are standing. Izarian started to walk toward [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and immediately, Izarian reached for [REDACTED] [REDACTED] was between them and can be seen attempting to push Izarian away. It appeared that Izarian grabbed onto [REDACTED] hair immediately and used that to move [REDACTED] around. Both parties fall the ground, which was when I observed them fighting. I attempted to view camera footage prior to the disturbance in an effort to figure out when [REDACTED] might have struck Izarian, but I was unable to track Izarian and [REDACTED] on the cameras to when they would have first had contact with one another. The video did confirm that the fight was only in front of Mr. Frogs and not related to inside the establishment.

Based on the observed actions, statements and camera footage, it appeared that Izarian initiated the disturbance and was the primary aggressor in the disturbance. The camera footage was logged as evidence. All parties were identified by WI DL.

Izarian was confined at Outagamie County jail for Battery WI SS 940.19(1) and

Disorderly Conduct WI SS 947.01(1). Izarian instigated a violent physical disturbance that was in a public space. Izarian also caused [REDACTED] to feel pain without [REDACTED]'s consent by pulling her hair and grabbing her. Izarian also continued to inform officers that she would engage in the behavior again and that it was worth going to jail over.

On 09/22/2024 at 2:18 AM while on duty for the City of Appleton Police Department I, Ofc. Van Dinter assisted on disturbance complaint at 409 W. College Ave. in the City and County of Wisconsin. I interviewed [REDACTED] [REDACTED] regarding this incident. [REDACTED] told me the other involved female, Izarian Lo, had attacked her for no reason and without provocation. I asked [REDACTED] if she knew Izarian and she told me her brother use to date her. [REDACTED] told me as she was walking past Mr. Froggs Izarian grabbed her by the hair and pulled her to the ground and struck her multiple times. [REDACTED] told me Izarian pulled chunks of her hair out. [REDACTED] stated Izarian caused her pain without her consent.

I spoke briefly with [REDACTED] [REDACTED] who confirmed [REDACTED] statement. I informed Ofc. Ballweg of my findings.

FORENSIC EVIDENCE SPECIALIST NICOLE DEL PLAINE #9513:

INJURY PHOTOGRAPHY

On 09/23/2024 I, Forensic Evidence Specialist Nicole del Plaine #9513, was working my scheduled shift when I captured injury photographs of an individual in relation to a battery incident (A24044935). The individual, later identified as Izarian "Izzy" Arlene Lo (DOB: 02/21/2001; F/B), was currently in the police department's lobby.

I prepared my camera equipment. All photographs would be captured on the manual RAW-Large setting per department policy. I wrote all pertinent case information on a grey card. The first photograph that I captured was of the grey card. I collected the following:

* Item #2: Izarian "Izzy" A. Lo [DOB: 02/21/2001; F/B] injury photographs (09/23/2024 at 1123 hours).

F.E.S. Kourtney Hyland would accompany me and assist with scale throughout this process.

We met Izarian in the lobby and moved to a lobby conference room for privacy. I explained that I would be taking a series of photographs depicting all injuries made known to us. Moreover, I advised if she were uncomfortable at any time, to let us know, and we would halt the process.

I asked that Izarian stand against a plain wall to ensure a neutral background. I began by capturing overall photographs. These would depict who I was photographing. Next, I asked Izarian to identify areas of pain and/or injury, whether visible or not. I captured mid-range and close-up photographs of each area that was mentioned. These photographs were taken with and without scale.

Izarian stated that she had bruising around her left eye. I observed visible discoloration around her left eye (eye socket), which appeared to be inflamed. There was some light reddening visible on her sclera (white portion of the eye), left of her pupil. Izarian also pointed out reddening on her right eye. This eye appeared significantly more irritated than the left. I observed reddening that was more substantial in size and color. This reddening was located on her sclera just left of her pupil.

Izarian identified bruising on her right breast, as well. I observed discoloration above and to the right of her areola.

Izarian described an injury to her left hand's middle finger. She stated that she had sought medical treatment for the finger following the incident, and that personnel had originally believed the finger had sustained a sprain. Later on, she received a call from the medical professional who concluded that she had sustained a fracture that finger. I observed Izarian's middle finger to be swollen and bent unlike her other fingers. The distal phalanx (area above the knuckle) was pink/blue in color.

Finally, Izarian stated that she felt pain on the left side of her forehead. She was unsure if there was any visible bruise. I captured photographs of the area, including some discoloration. It is unknown whether the discoloration was part of Izarian's complexion or if it was an injury.

After all photographs had been captured, we informed Izarian that she could contact us if she wanted additional photographs taken in the future. Then, I returned to the Identification Unit and secured my camera equipment in the Evidence Hold area. The photographs that I had taken for this case remained in this secure location until they could be logged into BEAST and transferred to

the proper digital evidence storage location.

This concluded my involvement with this case at this time.
