



Original Narrative

11/03/2024 23:11:00

On 11/02/1014 at approximately 0404 hours in the City of Appleton, Outagamie County WI, I, Officer Samuel Vassar #9158, was dispatched to 1338 W Spencer St for an after the fact domestic disturbance which occurred at Mr Frogs, located at 409 W College Ave. The complainant, who I later identified verbally as [REDACTED] F/W DOB: [REDACTED] stated that the father of her child, identified fully through records as George Q Baggett Jr M/B DOB 09/23/2000 had choked her while they were in the bar. She was not requesting an ambulance, and was waiting for officers at her residence.

I responded with FTO Van Dinter and made contact with [REDACTED] at her address. We were invited

inside and I began to question her what happened after confirming she did not want any immediate medical attention. Through my conversation with [REDACTED] she identified the relationship with George to be former boyfriend-girlfriend. [REDACTED] said they never lived together and were never married, but they do share a child in common, who was verbally identified as [REDACTED] F/U DOB: [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] said there is no custody agreement in place, and [REDACTED] is primarily cared for by her, as George is out of the picture as a parent, only visiting occasionally.

[REDACTED] said that very consistently for the last four years, she and George have not seen each other or spoken to each other, with the exception that because they primarily reside near the downtown area of Appleton, they might see each other unintentionally infrequently, and [REDACTED] would avoid having contact with George. Earlier in the night, [REDACTED] was at Mr Frogs with her friend who she identified as [REDACTED] F/B DOB: [REDACTED]. After a while at that bar, they proceeded to a different bar called the Leg Lamp Lounge, located at 427 W College Ave, before returning to Mr Frogs. When the general time frame of bar close came around, at approximately 0230 hours, [REDACTED] told me she was still in the bar, near the front door when she noticed George entering the bar. George approached [REDACTED] directly, and according to her, he pushed her against the wall which is perpendicular to the main entry door frame. [REDACTED] said she felt what she described as a shock, likely due to the disruption of fluids in her body, and that after this happened, George used both of his hands, which he placed around her neck. [REDACTED] said she felt George squeeze or tighten his grip around her neck to the point that she felt dizzy, and felt the inability to breathe.

[REDACTED] recalled that George was calling her various vulgar slurs as he was doing this, but she could only recall for certainty that he was repeatedly calling her a bitch. [REDACTED] told me she could not recall exactly how long this was happening for, but the disturbance was broken up by bouncers at the bar. [REDACTED] told me that George was there with some of his friends, and she has knowledge that many of the employees are also friends with him, and she was questioning herself if anybody was going to help her because it took such a long time for intervention. After the physical aspect of the disturbance ended, [REDACTED] said George left, and she did immediately after, walking straight to her residence with [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if there was anything that could have provoked such a physical response from George, and she told me that she feels he was trying to get back into a relationship with her. Additionally, [REDACTED] told me that when she goes out in public with friends and George notices her, she sometimes would be approached by him or receive messages which indicated to her George becomes jealous if she talks to other people. [REDACTED] advised she did not consent to being touched, strangled, injured, or be a part of any disturbance.

[REDACTED] told me that she should never have had a child with George because he never used to be violently aggressive like this. [REDACTED] detailed an incident that occurred approximately two to three months ago in the church parking lot across from our police department, during the same time of the morning, where George approached her and slapped her across the face. [REDACTED] said that was the first time George was ever physically violent with her and she was surprised, but regretted not immediately reporting the incident to our department because she did not think it would continue to happen. [REDACTED] stated that when she and George were in a relationship years ago, there would be intense verbal arguments, but nothing became physical.

I spoke with [REDACTED] about the dangers of not seeking medical attention regarding strangulation cases, even if she did not immediately feel symptoms. FTO Van Dinter proposed to [REDACTED] the option to have a brief examination conducted at a hospital by a SANE nurse, and she agreed. A SANE nurse was requested by FTO Van Dinter via phone, and we were advised one would be paged to respond to ThedaCare Medical Center - Appleton. I completed a Domestic Abuse Worksheet with [REDACTED] at that time while Officer Thor collected initial photos of redness as an ID Tech.

While further questioning during completion of the Domestic Abuse Worksheet, [REDACTED] said George has injured her in the past one time, and that was previously described to happen approximately two to three months ago. He also has threatened to injure her, her family and/or friends with homicide, but George never provided a manner of doing this. [REDACTED] did mention that George usually conceals a firearm on his person although he is a felon, and he has easy access to them. During the strangulation, [REDACTED] said she suffered a difficulty breathing and felt light headed. [REDACTED] told me she has been getting over a cold, but her symptoms of a hoarse and raspy voice along with trouble swallowing have been worse since the disturbance. The lethality assessment

questionnaire was completed and I notified [REDACTED] she was scored for high danger. [REDACTED] did not want to immediately talk to an advocate, but she consented to me sharing her information. [REDACTED] confirmed the form was completed with accuracy, and I provided her a Victim Information Packet.

I transported [REDACTED] to ThedaCare Medical Center - Appleton and evidence was collected pertaining to the strangulation. While listening in on the evidence collection, [REDACTED] made some concerning comments regarding her safety to the nurse to include "I'm scared to go to sleep", "I don't want to not wake up in the morning", and "[George] could've killed me". After the exam was completed, I provided [REDACTED] copies of already mentioned paperwork and confirmed she had no questions. I concluded my contact and transported the evidence kit to the Appleton Police Department where I packaged and entered it into the BEAST system. Harbor House was notified of this incident via phone call.

I was later notified that George was taken into custody by officers on 11/02/2024 at approximately 1137 hours and he was confined at the Outagamie County Jail. George did not wish to provide a statement. On 11/03/2024 at the start of 1900 shift, I attempted to make contact with [REDACTED] to obtain a witness statement, but was unsuccessful in person or by phone. I provided [REDACTED] in person a completed No Contact Prohibition form and explained to her what its contents meant, as she elected the period of no contact to be enforced for both three and five days as provided in Outagamie County. The scanned copy of the form was completed prior to George being taken into custody, and incorrect effective dates were later written on the form. I corrected the pink copy issued to [REDACTED] to include the effective dates. [REDACTED] was also questioned regarding when she last spoke to [REDACTED] and they recently did exchange text messages. [REDACTED] said she would ask [REDACTED] to contact our department when she leaves work in the City of Green Bay, WI later in the evening. Prior to concluding my contact, [REDACTED] was provided information regarding the use of Vine Link and CCAP website. She stated she had no questions and my contact concluded.

Attached to this report is a copy of the Domestic Abuse Worksheet, Lethality Assessment Screening, No Contact Prohibition, Conditional Release, BEAST Case Report, and ThedaCare Chain of Custody. Documents were digitally scanned. For more information, see supplements to this report.

It is requested that as part of bond conditions if George is provided the opportunity to post, for George to not enter any establishment whose primary purpose is sales of alcoholic beverages. George is also requested to not use any nonprescribed medication or consume any alcoholic beverages upon release as a significant amount of our department's contacts with George occur near bars.

OFFICER THOR #9133 SUPPLEMENT:

On 11/02/2024 at approximately 0435, I, Officer Thor #9133, was requested to respond to 1338 W Spencer St to take photographs. As an evidence technician, I have received proper training in scene photography and evidence collection.

I arrived on Spencer St and obtained the APD digital camera. After setting the digital camera up, I went inside the residence where Officer Vassar informed me that the victim, identified as [REDACTED] had injuries. I introduced myself and asked her about her injuries. [REDACTED] indicated that she had been strangled. [REDACTED] consented to having her injuries photographed.

I began with overall photos of [REDACTED] before moving closer to her injuries. I observed on [REDACTED] neck severe redness on her right, left, and center of her neck. I took several photos of these injuries at different angles, with and without flash. [REDACTED] stated that these were to only injuries that she had. I then left the residence.

On 11/02/2024 at approximately 2324 hours, I heard officers advised that they were out with George Baggett on the 400blk of W College Ave. I knew that Officer Vassar had probable cause to arrest George for charges related to this incident. I responded to the 400blk of W College Ave and upon arrival, George was in custody. While George was searched incident to an arrest, Officer Grier-Welch was given a tobacco packaging. Within the packaging, Officer Grier-Welch informed me that there was suspected marijuana inside. I took custody of this item and also observed a green leafy substance that I suspected to be marijuana based on my training and experiences.

George was placed in my squad and transported to the Appleton Police Department. I read George his Miranda Rights and when asked if he understood his rights, he would only answer "I guess". He would then ask why he was arrested multiple times. I tried explaining to George that I would like to talk to him, however as he was in custody, I needed to know if he understood his rights. George did not give me a valid answer. George wanted to know why he was arrested and I informed him that he was involved in a disturbance that occurred at Mr. Frogs. George would ask me about the disturbance, however at this time, George did not answer yes that he understood his rights. George would continue to ask about the disturbance, however I decided to stop talking to George as he was ignoring my question as to his understanding of his rights.

George was ultimately transported to Outagamie County Jail. Once at the jail, I read George the 72-hour no contact prohibition. After George was taken out of hand cuffs, I signed that 72-hour no contact form. George was released to jail staff without incident. The 72-hour form was given to

Officer Vassar.

I later tested the suspected marijuana located on George. Before testing, I weighed the substance which was 0.23 grams. I then tested the substance with the Mobile Detect, specifically for marijuana/THC, which yielded positive for marijuana. The marijuana was logged into APD Evidence. I also logged the SD card I used to capture [REDACTED] injuries into APD Evidence. The evidence report for the items I logged in was attached to this report. I decided to issued George a citation for AC 10-32 Possession of Marijuana. I gave the Outagamie County Jail staff the citation.

This concluded my involvement.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

On 11/02/2024 at approximately 23:25, I, Officer Joseph Basak #9124 with the Appleton Police Department, was assigned to the College Avenue Detail from 23:00 to 03:00, in full uniform, and on foot patrol in the 400 Block of West College Avenue, City of Appleton, Outagamie County, Wisconsin.

Lieutenant West #9119, who was on foot patrol with me, made contact with a male who he was able to positively identify as ADULT OFFENDER George Baggett. Officer Vassar #9158 and his Field Training Officer, Officer Van Dinter #9148, had notified units that George needed to be confined on several Domestic Violence charges. Officer Ballweg #9167 and Lieutenant West maintained arm control while I placed George in handcuffs. I checked the handcuffs for fit and comfort before safety locking them. After completing a search incident to arrest, George was escorted to a squad car and subsequently transported to the Outagamie County Jail.

This concluded my involvement with this case. For additional information, reference the original narrative and all other supplemental narratives. My Axon BWC was activated throughout this contact.

On 11/02/24, I, Lt. West, was working as a patrol supervisor for the Appleton Police Department. During my shift I was in uniform, operating marked squad 1037. At approximately 2324 hrs., I was conducting foot patrol in the 400 blk of W. College Ave. I was also aware that Officers Vassar and Van Dinter had probable cause to arrest George Baggett for numerous charges reference this

case. I know Baggett through past professional contacts and am aware that he frequents the downtown bar district in Appleton.

While in the 400 blk of W. College Ave. I observed a male subject identified as, [REDACTED], walking westbound on College Ave. towards my location. I knew that [REDACTED] had been hanging out with Baggett the night before on College Ave., thus I began to scan the subjects that were walking with [REDACTED] to see if Baggett was one of them. I noticed a subject walking with [REDACTED] that was wearing a pink balaclava. The balaclava was concealing his face however the subject eventually said something, and I immediately recognized the voice as Baggett's. I told Baggett he was under arrest. I assisted with taking control of Baggett's left arm while he was placed in handcuffs. He was eventually secured in a squad and confined at OCJ. For further details see officers' narratives.

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE:

On 11/03/2024 during my shift of 1500 hours to 2300 hours, I reviewed Avigilon Traffic Camera Surveillance during the time of this reported incident. Nothing was captured that happened inside the establishment, but [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were seen rushing out of the establishment, pausing on the sidewalk area directly in front, and it appeared [REDACTED] was consoling [REDACTED]. Both parties left walking westbound and George Baggett exited shortly later walking in the same direction. The video was bookmarked and entered into BEAST.

I attempted contact in person with [REDACTED] and was unsuccessful. Several attempts were made to obtain a witness statement from her through a phone call but she did not answer, and I left a voicemail requesting a call back. I additionally attempted contact with the owner of Mr Frogs, identified through in-house records as Vanessa M Alvarado F/W DOB: 03/04/1990 at her registered DOT address but she did not appear to be home. I attempted phone contact with Vanessa but left a voicemail requesting a phone call back in attempt to obtain interior surveillance footage.

On 11/07/2024 during my shift of 1900 hours to 0700 hours, I attempted phone contact with both [REDACTED] and Vanessa again, but was unsuccessful and left voicemails requesting a callback. Follow up to continue attempting to obtain a witness statement from [REDACTED] and with Vanessa to obtain interior surveillance video if possible to show the incident.

I also made phone contact with [REDACTED] at approximately 1838 hours, and she told me she didn't remember much from the night of this incident, because she said she was "blacked out" intoxicated. [REDACTED] said she could speak towards George Baggett's general behavior as a person, but she had no information to provide regarding [REDACTED] being strangled in the establishment by George.

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE

On 02/14/2025 I received a report of laboratory findings from the Wisconsin State Crime Laboratory. Upon review of the report, DNA Analyst [REDACTED] detailed that upon testing of item A1a, skin to skin contact bilateral neck swabs collected from [REDACTED], a four (4) person DNA mixture was identified with the DNA of at least one belonging to a male. Laboratory findings were digitally attached to this report.

On 02/17/2025 I was provided access to review phone calls made to and from George Baggett while he was confined at the Outagamie County Jail on charges from this case. A total of 277 phone calls were recorded. As time permitted, I began to review these records and took note of calls which held some evidentiary value relevant to this case. Noteworthy calls were made directly after George's confinement began and were documented as follows:

On 11/04/2024 at 1847 hours, George called [REDACTED]. This phone number is associated through in-house records to [REDACTED] F/B DOB: [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was associated with George in previous reports as they were roommates. The female George speaks to, assumed to be [REDACTED] indicated that she spoke with [REDACTED]. During the call, [REDACTED] was telling George what [REDACTED] said to her. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she was not trying to press charges, and that she forgot to tell the police that she was "kicking and smacking" George, but George needed to learn his lesson. George expressed frustration to [REDACTED] that he felt the police were too quick to make an arrest based off of one person's story. It is important to reiterate that when George was taken into custody by our department, he declined providing any sort of a statement to assist with finding the facts surrounding what occurred during this disturbance as he would not advise he understood his Miranda rights.

On 11/04/2024 at 1919 hours, George called [REDACTED]. Through an internet search, I identified the owner as [REDACTED] F/B DOB: [REDACTED] and confirmed that both she and George were associated through in-house records. I presumed the female speaking with George was [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] indicated she had recently spoken with [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] apparently told [REDACTED] that she was going to do everything she could with the police, including going to the hospital, in order to get George "locked up".

On 11/04/2024 at 1919 hours, George called [REDACTED]. I was unable to identify the owner of this phone number, but through context of the conversation, I confirmed the user of that phone number was a female who was pregnant with George's child. She indicated she also recently spoke with [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] told her George got mad at her because she "fucked" someone he was associated with, although I was not able to determine what the supposed relationship was due to the quality of the audio. George rebutted by stating to the caller that he was approached by [REDACTED] while he was in the bar, and [REDACTED] was making statements to him, telling George that she felt sorry for him and she felt sorry that the caller was his "baby mama". George continued to state that [REDACTED] had approached him and some other people his was with several times with acting aggressive, including a point during a verbal disturbance where [REDACTED] kicked him and smacked his drink out of his hand.

At the start of my shift on 02/28/2025, I proceeded to [REDACTED] address in attempt to make contact with her for further questioning after review of these phone calls. I was advised by family members that [REDACTED] was out of town for the weekend, so I elected to make phone contact with her at that time. I explained my reasoning for following up with [REDACTED] and explained the context of the three (3) detailed phone calls. Aubrey confirmed that she was contacted by [REDACTED] who is actually George's mother very shortly after George was arrested. [REDACTED] did tell [REDACTED] what happened, and she did not recall telling [REDACTED] anything about forgetting to report that she was physically violent with George. [REDACTED] denied that any of this had happened, which aligned with her initial statement. I questioned [REDACTED] about her contact with [REDACTED] and I learned she had never met [REDACTED] but [REDACTED] did reach out to her at or around the time of the reported incident. This was the only time that [REDACTED] had spoken with [REDACTED] and she denied making any statements to [REDACTED] pertaining to George being arrested under malice. I also questioned [REDACTED] about the third phone call detailed in this supplement. [REDACTED] told me that she did have romantic relations with another male that George was friends with, and she said this did make George mad. [REDACTED] wished to not disclose the identity of this friend, as she no longer is in contact with him, and he had moved out of the area. [REDACTED] said she knew that George threatened this individual, saying he was going to kill the party. [REDACTED] explained George likely said this because of his jealousy which grows whenever he learns of [REDACTED] attempting to get in another relationship, as was detailed during the initial investigation.

Prior to concluding my contact with [REDACTED] she said that she received messages from George within days of his arrest which were threatening in nature, and she did save those, but the incident was not reported to us. I at that time had to abruptly end the phone conversation to attend to an unrelated matter, but I left [REDACTED] a voicemail with a request to reach back out to me if she wished for me to investigate further the messages she had received from George.

All audio files were downloaded to an external USB drive and entered as evidence for this complaint. Attached is a Beast Case Report. No further information.

SGT YULE #9168 REPORTS: I was assigned to assist in this investigation by obtaining a buccal swab of George Q Baggett, DOB 9/23/2000, in order to compare to DNA samples already sent to the WI State Crime Lab. I had attempted numerous times to contact Baggett's attorney, unsuccessfully. I was similarly unable to locate him so I could obtain a search warrant, until 3/21/2025. On that day, I found that he had been confined at the Winnebago County Jail. I obtained a search warrant for Baggett's DNA, and on 3/21/2025, I executed that warrant at the Winnebago County jail. After obtaining Baggett's DNA via buccal swabs, I logged the swabs into evidence at the APD, and notified the Identification Unit of the pending trial, and that evidence was entered post-discovery. I completed the warrant return on that same day. The execution of the search warrant was recorded via Axon Capture and uploaded.
