Narratives**Original Narrative****12/16/2024 07:26:02****OFFICER RUDEBECK REPORTING:**

On 12-13-2024 I, Officer Rudebeck #9193, was assigned to the College Avenue Detail from 2200-0300. I was dressed in full uniform and in marked squad 956. At approximately 2306 hours, I was dispatched to a disturbance located at Mr. Frogs located at 409 W College Ave.

Dispatch had indicated that a female was throwing bottles at the door of Mr. Frogs, had ripped off a door handle from the front entrance, and was trying to break a window. The reporting party had mentioned that the female suspect had left and had walked into Chadwicks located at 413 W College Ave. While arriving on scene, dispatch had said the female suspect was white, heavier set, and was wearing a brown jacket.

I located a female matching the description walking westbound in front of The Bar located at 427 W College Ave. The female was identified by a social security card and Spillman in-house as Sarah George. Sarah had claimed that while inside of Mr. Frogs, several males started to grab her and removed her from the bar. Sarah claimed she was unsure why the male parties had done this. Sarah insinuated that she was being targeted because she was a female. While I spoke with Sarah, she began to yell at other pedestrians and was swearing. Due to her continued behavior of doing this after I had told her to stop, Sarah was detained and was placed into handcuffs that were properly fitted and double locked. Sarah was escorted to a nearby squad so I could speak with the manager and an employee at Mr. Frogs.

When I spoke with Bryan Mendoza, who was a manager at Mr. Frogs, I was told that Sarah had caused a disturbance inside of Mr. Frogs and that the bouncers including himself had removed Sarah from the bar. While Sarah was outside the bouncer who was verbally identified as Anthony Little, closed the door to prevent Sarah from coming back inside. Bryan said that Sarah had kicked the door and pulled on the door handle hard enough that the handle was ripped off. Bryan said that to repair the door it would cost approximately \$1,000.00-\$2,000.00. After the door handle was ripped off, Bryan had watched Sarah walk into Chadwicks with the door handle in her hand and shortly after exited Chadwicks and continued to walk westbound. Ofc. Vandinter #9148 had taken photos of the damaged door to Mr. Frogs and uploaded them to Axon Capture. Ofc. Thor #9133 had informed me that there was video footage of the disturbance on traffic camera. Bryan said that he would email me video of the disturbance inside of Mr. Frogs at a later date.

I spoke with Anthony who was a bouncer for Mr. Frogs and was told that he noticed that Sarah was pushing other customers and had thrown a drink. Anthony began to escort Sarah out and due to her refusing to leave the bar, Anthony had to wrap his arms around her to walk her out. Once Sarah was outside of the Mr. Frogs, Sarah began to kick the door, which was described as a mule kick by Anthony. Anthony mentioned that Sarah had pulled onto the door handle of the front

entrance trying to open the door and had ripped off the door handle.

I later arrived at Chadwicks and spoke with [REDACTED] who was identified verbally. [REDACTED] said that he recalled Sarah walking into the bar and noticed that she was holding a door handle. [REDACTED] had told Sarah that she was not allowed in the bar and Sarah exited. [REDACTED] mentioned that Sarah had left the door handle inside of the bar and had later retrieved it and handed it to me. The door handle was later logged into BEAST for evidence.

After I had finished speaking with [REDACTED] I was advised that Sgt. Zieman #9112 had located a small plastic baggie with a white powdery substance. Based on my training and experience, I believed that it was cocaine. Sgt. Zieman also mentioned that Sarah had an open case through Outagamie as well. For more information, please reference Ofc. Zieman's supplemental report. Sarah was later transported by Ofc. Thor #9133 and Ofc. Vandinter #9148.

When I returned to the PD, I reviewed traffic cameras and observed Antony Little push Sarah out of Mr. Frogs at approximately 2304 hours. Anthony then closed the door and Sarah walked back up the steps and attempted to open the door. I observed the door open slightly due to how hard Sarah was pulling against the door while Anthony attempted to keep the door closed. Sarah then started to mule kick the door several times. After Sarah had kicked the door several times, Sarah again began to pull onto the door handle, which caused it to rip off. Sarah then lost her balance and fell down the stairs with the door handle in her hand. The video that I had observed was logged into evidence.

On 12/13/24 at approximately 2314 hours I arrived at College/Walnut as I saw Officer Rudebeck detaining a female suspect (Sarah George) in handcuffs. There was a purse on the ground next to Sarah, and I heard Officer Rudebeck inform her that we would take possession of her purse. Sgt. Zieman informed me Sarah was under arrest for Misdemeanor Bail Jumping.

I began to search Sarah's purse incident to arrest. There was a wallet inside the purse. Within one of the wallet's compartments I observed a clear plastic corner cut baggie containing a white powdery substance I suspected to be illegal drugs (possibly cocaine). Sgt. Zieman was next to me when I located the suspected drugs. I turned the wallet and suspected drugs over to Sgt. Zieman.

This concluded my involvement in this case.

SUPPLEMENTAL REPORT

On 12/13/24 at approximately 23:06, I, SSgt. Thomas Ziemann #9112, responded to Mr. Frogs at 409 W. College Ave. for a reported disturbance along with Ofcs. Rudebeck #9193, VanDinter #9148, and Thor #9133. The initial information provided was that a "bigger" white female was acting wildly, and had pulled the door handle off of the entry door and was hitting it against the glass.

Shortly after dispatch, Ofc. Rudebeck and I arrived on scene along with Ofc. VanDinter and Ofc. Thor shortly thereafter. As we were dismounting from my squad, a Dispatch provided an updated description that the female was now walking toward The Bar, near a male in a black and white jacket. It was at this time that we located a female party matching the given description and made contact with her on W. College Ave. at Walnut St.

The female immediately made unsolicited remarks about being at Speak Easy and getting kicked out and pulling off the door handle, which she later clarified as actually being Mr. Frogs. As such, it was apparent that this was the suspect we were looking for. I asked the female for an ID, to which she ultimately provided to me her social security card. I then returned to my squad and subsequently identified her as ADULT OFFENDER Sarah George by social security number, WI DOT photo, and previous booking photo. I then checked WI CCCP and found that she had an open case under 2024CM000019 through Outagamie Co. with the specific bond information listed as active:

01-08-2024 Signature bond signed for George, Sarah M.
\$750.00

Additional text:

The defendant shall appear on all court dates; give written notice to the Clerk of Court within 48 hours of any change of address or telephone number; shall not commit any crime; shall neither directly nor indirectly threaten, harass, intimidate or otherwise interfere with victims or witnesses in this action. Call the Outagamie County Sheriff's Dept. at (920) 832-5633 within 48 hours for fingerprints and/or photos (to be completed within 21 days). The Defendant is to maintain absolute sobriety for pendency of case, except for prescribed medication. No Contact with JJ Maloney's Bar.

Based on my previous contact with Sarah where I could plainly smell the odor of intoxicating beverages from her person, I determined she was in violation of her open bond. As such, I returned to Ofcs. Thor and Rudebeck, who already had Sarah detained and were securing her in the car. I informed them of the open case and my intention on arresting and confining her on the bail jumping, as she previously held a bench warrant for the same case several months prior, and therefore had a demonstrated history with not complying with bond/court orders.

Since Sarah was now in custody, Lt. Goodin #9182 began a search of her property, incident to arrest. As he was searching Sarah's wallet that she had earlier shown me with her cards in it, I saw a small, plastic tied off bag end containing a white powder inside one of the pockets in the wallet. Based on my training and experience as a drug detector K9 handler, I suspected that the baggie contained cocaine due to its composition and packaging. I then took the wallet from Lt. Goodin and completed the search, and later fielded tested the substance using Serchie cocaine field test wipe, which tested positive for the presence of cocaine. This item was retained and logged into APD as evidence. At the same time, I also assisted in logging in the door handle that Sarah had pulled off from Mr. Frogs as evidence.

While conducting the drug component of the investigation, Ofcs. VanDinter and Rudebeck completed their investigation regarding the disorderly conduct and property damage committed by Sarah. See their reports for detail. After this was done, Sarah was then transported and booked into the Outagamie Co. Jail by Ofcs. Thor and VanDinter.

OFFICER THOR #9133 SUPPLEMENT:

On 12/14/2024 at approximately 2305 hours, I, Officer Thor #9133, responded to assist officers for a disturbance at Mr. Frogs, 409 W College Ave. The call notes stated that a "bigger" female white was trying to break the window with a metal bar.

As I arrived, additional call notes stated that the female was wearing a brown jacket and walking towards The Bar. I observed a female matching the description and exited my squad. I then told the female, later identified as Sarah George, stop after announcing that I was from the Appleton Police Department. Sarah stopped and Officer Rudebeck #9193 interviewed her while I checked traffic footage. I viewed Alta Aware traffic footage and later informed Officer Rudebeck that the incident was on the video footage.

Sarah was detained in handcuffs by Officer Rudebeck due to her behavior. Sarah was placed in the rear of my squad. Sgt. Zieman then informed me that Sarah was under arrest as she violated her bond conditions. Sarah asked why she was under arrest and I informed her that she had an open Outagamie Court Case with a specific rule to maintain absolute sobriety. Sarah stated that was sober and requested a PBT. I administered a PBT which the result was .110.

After completion of Officer Rudebeck's investigation, I transported Sarah to the Outagamie County Jail where was booked and released to jail staff. This ended my involvement with this incident.

On 12/16/2024 at 23:06 PM while on duty for the City of Appleton Police Department I, Ofc. Van Dinter assisted on a damage complaint at Mr. Froggs, 409 W. College Ave. City of Appleton, Outagamie County, Wisconsin.

Upon arrival I spoke with Anthony J. Little Jr; M/B DOB:10/15/1989, who is an employee for Mr. Froggs. Anthony stated the female, later identified as Sarah M. George, F/W DOB:09/02/1982, was talking to another unknown male patron in the tavern when she got upset and threw her beverage in his face. Anthony stated he escorted her out of the business after she refused to leave. Anthony stated once Sarah was outside she began kicking on the front access door to the business with her heel. Anthony stated Sarah then forcefully pulled the handle off the door causing damage without consent. Anthony stated Sarah also caused damage to the frame of the door. I took photographs of the damage and uploaded them to evidence.com. I issued a crime victim worksheet to the business.

I assisted with confining Sarah at the Outagamie County Jail. I completed a probable cause statement on Ofc. Rudebeck's behalf.
