Original Narrative

12/26/2024 06:06:19

On 12/26/24 at approximately 01:17 hours, I, Officer Looker 9170, was dispatched to Mr. Frogs at 409 W College Ave for a male that was laying outside that business that needed an ambulance. Upon arrival, I found Tracy Bass on his knees outside the entrance to Mr. Frogs. Tracy had a red substance that appeared to be blood, based on my police training and experience, on his snow pants and hands. Tracy was holding his hand out and I saw that his middle finger on his right hand had a open wound and had what appeared to look like bone showing.

I requested a medic, and medic 7 took Tracy and brought him to St. E's.

Officer Derge 9147 spoke with the bouncer, Jaron Cashaw, and Mr. Frog's employees. Officer Derge 9147 also received video surveillance footage from bar staff of the disturbance between Tracy and Jaron. Please see Officer Derge's 9147 supplement for more information.

Officer Derge 9147 showed me the video surveillance footage. In the footage, Tracy is seen entering the bar and the bouncer, Jaron, was attempting to escort Tracy out. Tracy then used an open palm to strike Jaron near the face region. Jaron then "threw" Tracy out of the bar, where Tracy then hurt his hand.

Please see Officer Derge's supplement for information on his conversation with the bouncer, Jaron.

Based upon the video surveillance footage, the information provided by Officer Derge from Jaron, I cited Tracy an ordinance violation for Disorderly Conduct. I noticed Tracy was on probation and had several rules:

Tracy broke DOC rule SP 014 DV as he engaged in physical behavior that was violent in nature, SP 023 SU - as he was on the premise of an establishment whose primary purpose was the sale or distribution of alcohol, including but not limited to bars, taverns, liquor stores, and beer tents. I called DOC After Hours who requested a hold on Tracy.

I went to St. E's and advised Tracy of his Disorderly Conduct ordinance violation and of his probation hold. Tracy's finger was taken care of by medical staff, and he was medically cleared. I placed handcuffs on Tracy in the front due to his finger injury, and checked them for fit. I then safety locked the handcuffs. I searched Tracy prior to placing him in the back of my squad. Nothing was found on Tracy. I transported Tracy to OCJ where he was transferred over to jail staff.

On 12/26/2024 at approximately 0117 hours, I, Officer Derge #9147 with the Appleton Police Department, responded to Mr. Frogs, located at 409 W College Ave, Appleton, Outagamie County, WI, for a 911 misdial. The RP, later identified as Tracy Bass, reported he had been at a bar on college and was pushed down. Lt Botz #9199 advised he observed on traffic camera footage a male on the ground outside of the bar.

Upon arrival, I observed Tracy sat near the stairs to the entrance of Mr Frogs. I noticed Tracy had been bleeding from his right hand. His middle finger appeared to be out of place, there was a 1 inch laceration was bleeding, and there was swelling around the injury location. Medical was requested at that time. I then turned my attention to a male, identified via WI ID as Jaron Cashaw, who stated he was the bouncer working.

Jaron informed me Tracy had come to the bar an hour prior and was denied entry as he did not have an ID. Tracy later entered the bar without Jaron's knowledge. When Jaron noticed Tracy in the bar, he told Tracy to leave. Tracy refused to leave. Jaron escorted Tracy by his arm. Tracy began to resist this action to guide him out of the bar. Tracy then began to grab at Jaron. When they were near the front door, Tracy pushed Jaron's face with an open hand. Jaron then pushed Tracy out of the business.

Jaron stated Tracy did not cause him pain. Jaron did not wish to pursue charges. Jaron provided camera footage of the incident. The camera footage was consistent with Jaron's statement. Video was obtained and uploaded via Axon Capture.

Tracy was brought to St Elizabeth's Hospital where he was treated for his injuries. While at the hospital, I assisted Officer Looker #9170 in taking Tracy into custody where he was later transported to OCJ for a probation violation.
