### Original Narrative

**02/17/2025 16:07:47**

Officer Ballweg Reporting #9167:

On February 16th, 2025, around 0137 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I operated a marked APD patrol car with the identification number #1015. I was on foot at the intersection of W College Ave and N Division St in Appleton, WI 54911, Outagamie County. Officer Berens #9183 and I observed a crowd starting to form in front of 409 W College Ave, Mr. Frogs, Appleton, WI 54911, Outagamie. We could hear people in the crowd talking

about fighting.

We walked over toward the crowd, and I was able to identify [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] based on prior incidents. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] appeared to be trying to get people in the crowd to walk away from one another. Once we were next to the crowd, [REDACTED] asked me to have a female, later identified as Clea Bowden, walk away from the rest of the people. [REDACTED] told me that Clea was trying to fight other people in the crowd. I requested that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have the people they were with walk away and [REDACTED] refused to do that. I spoke with Clea and asked her to walk away from the group. Clea asked if I could give her the names of the people in the group. I explained to Clea that I could not give her that information and asked her to walk away from the scene to avoid an escalation of issues. She then asked what would happen if she would "demolish" the other individuals and I informed her that she would then be arrested if she started a physical fight.

The other people kept arguing and continued to yell about Clea. Clea and another female started to walk toward each other, so I put myself between them and put a hand on Clea's shoulder to keep her away from the other female, since Clea had already made the statement regarding "demolishing" the other individuals. I continued to tell Clea to walk away and Clea stepped back from me and the other people. I then watched her plant her feet, remove her jacket and drop it to the ground. As she did that, I saw her staring over my shoulder at the female that had been arguing with her. Clea started to walk toward me while staring at the other female. Based on Clea dropping her coat and doing what I knew to be a thousand yard stare, both of which were pre-attack postures, I believed Clea was going to assault the female. I grabbed Clea by both her shoulders and stepped in front of her. She continued to try to push past me and turn her shoulders, which I believed was her attempt to break my grip. I then started to push her back and she continued to try to move forward. At that point, I could hear louder yelling behind me and was concerned about other individuals involving themselves. I determined that I would be unable to effectively detain Clea while she was standing, since she was not cooperating with me. I put my right foot behind her legs and utilized a modified leg wheel to decentralize her. As I did that my left foot slipped on ice and snow that was on the sidewalk. Clea landed on her back, and I landed on my right side. Officer Beren's and I were able to move Clea to her stomach and attempted to bring her arms behind her back, while giving her commands to put her arms behind her back. Clea straightened her arms and originally prevented us from placing her arms behind her back. We were eventually able to get her arms behind her back, but I could feel that her arms were tensed the entire time.

Clea was secured into handcuffs, and the handcuffs were checked for fit and double locked. Clea told me that she had been attacked and that she did not do anything. Clea had not mentioned being attacked when I was asking her to leave the area. We stood her up and started to walk her to a squad across the street. The other involved female left the area while officers were with Clea. I informed Clea that she was under arrest. Clea told us that her knee was injured and then started to limp. She had not been limping prior to that. We asked if she needed medical attention, and she requested an ambulance. I wanted to remove Clea from the avenue to prevent any further issues, so Gold Cross was requested to meet us at the Appleton Police Department. I searched Clea and she was placed in my squad car. Clea's property was held by Officer Allen #9134. I transported Clea to the Appleton Police Department.

While at the police department, I asked Clea to identify herself and she originally refused to do so. There was no form of identification located in her property. Clea told me her identification had been stolen. Clea eventually verbally identified herself as [REDACTED]. She provided an address that matched the DOT return for [REDACTED] which had been updated in 2024. The DOT was similar. It was later discovered that Clea was not [REDACTED] and had falsely identified herself. Clea made several statements about how officers would burn for what they were doing. She informed us that it was a promise. Clea also explained that she had been attacked inside of Mr. Frogs. She had been struck three times. Clea was unable to provide any specific information regarding that incident.

Medical services arrived to assess Clea and Clea explained that her knee was out of place due to the incident. Medical applied pressure to Clea's knee and she did not react. Medical asked her what injury she had, since she was not reacting and she became uncooperative with and refused further treatment. I transported Clea to the Outagamie County jail. When walking her into the booking

room, Clea was walking without issue and attempted to pull away from me again. Clea did not start limping again until after the handcuffs were removed. Clea was originally confined under the name of [REDACTED]

Shortly after that, I was contacted by correction deputies, who informed me that Clea was not [REDACTED]. There had been several people call the jail asking about a Clea and when talking on the phone Clea said "It's Clea, I mean [REDACTED]". I reviewed a prior booking photo for Clea and Clea's Facebook <https://www.facebook.com/Itzmebytch>. Correction deputies and I agreed it was actually Clea. Clea was on parole. I contacted the after-hours and advised them of the situation. After-hours advised that Clea would be placed on a hold.

On February 16th, 2025, around 1930 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I operated a marked APD patrol car with the identification number #1015. I attempted to contact [REDACTED] to see if she had given Clea consent to falsely use her information. I was unable to get in contact with [REDACTED] by the phone numbers that I located for her. I left voicemails and will wait for a response.

The camera footage of the incident on Avigilon and Alta Aware was bookmarked and logged into evidence.

Officer Allen #9134 had completed his supplement and ended his shift before Clea was correctly identified. When he referred to [REDACTED] in his supplement, that was actually Clea.

### Supplement

On Sunday, February 16, 2025 at 0135 hours, I, Officer Charles Allen 9134, was assigned to the College Avenue detail from 2200-0300 hours, in a marked squad car, and body camera activated. I was standing in the 400 block of W. College Avenue near a group of people. There was a black female, wearing a black jacket and black hat standing near the group and the group had indicated they wanted her to walk away from them; the female was later identified as [REDACTED]. At one point, the group had someone trying to keep the parties separated and Officer Ballweg had tried talking with [REDACTED] and the group to keep them separated. [REDACTED] then started to walk towards the group and Officer Ballweg stepped in between. [REDACTED] then took off her jacket, in what appeared to be a

preattack posture, and then tried going around Officer Ballweg, lunging towards the group.

Officer Ballweg and [REDACTED] then went to the ground. I assisted in securing her legs as she was trying to kick her legs out. After [REDACTED] was taken into custody, she was escorted across College Avenue. [REDACTED] coat and property were secured in my squad car. I requested Gold Cross Ambulance meet officers at the police department as [REDACTED] complained of leg pain. I followed Officer Ballweg to the police department. [REDACTED] was checked on by Appleton FD and GCA and taken to the Outagamie County Jail. I assisted in completing booking paperwork and [REDACTED] was released to jail staff. End of supplement, 9134. Officer Ballweg Reporting #9167:

On February 20th, 2025, around 1900 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I operated a marked APD patrol car with the identification number #1015. I received a voicemail from a female identifying herself as [REDACTED]. In the voicemail, [REDACTED] explained that it was likely her sister, Clea Bowden, who had used her information.

At 1938 hours, I was able to make contact with [REDACTED]. I explained the incident to her and how Clea had identified herself as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] informed me that she did not give Clea consent to use her information to avoid punishment and wanted to be a victim. [REDACTED] lived outside of Appleton and was currently working. I verbally identified her over the phone with her birthday and current address. The phone number that she was calling from was also confirmed to be [REDACTED] through TLO. [REDACTED] opted out of services. Lt. Edwards #9216 approved me mailing [REDACTED] a victim packet.

Clea was no longer in custody at the time of my conversation with [REDACTED]. I will be referring Clea for an additional charge of Misappropriate ID information-avoid penalty WI SS 943.201(2)(B). Clea intentionally used [REDACTED] personal identifying information by telling me that she was [REDACTED] and provided her address. She did so to avoid the penalty associated with committing a crime while on parole and the other charges she was receiving. She did so without the consent of [REDACTED].

Officer Ballweg Reporting #9167:

On March 1st, 2025, around 2115 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I was operating my marked patrol squad #1015. I responded to 409 W College Ave, Mr. Frogs, Appleton, WI 54911, Outagamie County. I had received a request for follow up from the Outagamie County District Attorney's office. They were requested I check if Mr. Frogs had any camera footage of the incident.

I spoke with a staff member, who informed me that the only person able to view the cameras was Sandra Munoz. While I was at the establishment, I observed that there did not appear to be any cameras inside of the building that were pointing outside and the exterior camera at the front appeared to be pointed away from the sidewalk and back toward the interior of the building. I called Sandra and she informed me that she did not have access to the cameras and provided me with the information for Vanessa Alvarado. Vanessa was the owner of the establishment and would be able to review footage with me.

I eventually spoke with Vanessa, who informed me that she was the only one with access to the cameras. They saved the camera footage for approximately one month. She went on to explain that she would not have a good time that she would be able to review the camera footage with me and also mentioned that there were not any cameras that would have shown the sidewalk in front of the business. The only exterior camera was angled toward the front to make sure that bouncers were checked identification. I sent her an AXON community upload link and requested that she send all of the camera footage from 0130 till 0140 hours for 2/16/25. She informed me that she would upload the footage when possible. Once the footage is uploaded a further supplement will be completed.

Vanessa and Sandra were identified verbally over the phone.

I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I was operating my marked patrol squad #1015. I had received confirmation that Vanessa had uploaded three videos via the Axon Community Link. I reviewed that videos and saw that the videos were from 0130, 0145, and 0200, on February 16th, 2025. The videos are not able to capture any of the disturbance outside of the bar. The camera at 0130 hours showed [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] speaking with the unidentified female that had later left the scene. Clea was not seen in the camera footage provided.
