Officer Ballweg Reporting #9167:

On March 3rd, 2025, around 0208 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I was operating my marked patrol squad #1015. I had responded to 409 W College Ave, Mr Frogs, Appleton, WI 54911, Outagamie County. I was there for the disturbance that was documented under A25009721. While investigating the disturbance, I was made aware of an ordinance violation.

The bartender for Mr Frogs, Nayeli Tierrablanca, had people inside of the establishment past 0200 hours. After reviewing Alta Aware and Avigilon Camera footage, it showed that people were still inside of the establishment after 0200 hours. The footage was uploaded to evidence. The physical disturbance under A25009721 did not take place until 0207 hours. Video showed the individuals involved coming out of the bar at that time to fight. Several of them were then brought back into the bar by Nayeli. I spoke with Nayeli and she informed me that the disturbance had taken place outside of Mr Frogs, so the establishment could not be held accountable for the situation. Nayeli also informed the patrons inside to tell officers that the entire disturbance had taken part outside, so that "It could not be used against Frogs."

After officers confronted Nayeli about the open after-hours violation, she explained that the disturbance had started inside of the bar, and she was unable to remove the patrons on time because they were being disruptive. When asked why she did not call the police to remove the

patrons before violating the ordinance, she did not have an answer. Lt. West #9119 also spoke with Nayeli and determined that she was intoxicated while working.

On March 5th, 2025, around 2000 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I was operating my marked patrol squad #1015. I contacted Vanessa Alvarado to speak with her about the ordinance violation. Vanessa was the license premise holder for the establishment. I spoke with Vanessa over the phone. She wanted to know if they would be cited for the open after-hours AC 9-52(4). I explained that they would likely receive a citation, but I wanted to review the cameras from the inside of the bar before I issued one. I wanted to see if Nayeli had been honest about the disturbance occurring inside, which was why she was unable to remove the patrons prior to 0200 hours. Vanessa informed me that she would send me the camera footage to review. I also informed Vanessa that Nayeli was intoxicated at time of contact, which Vanessa had not been aware of. Vanessa informed me that Nayeli typically worked on Saturday nights. I asked if Nayeli knew that the bar had to be shut down by 0200 hours on Mondays and Vanessa stated "No, we told her, we told her, she's just not the brightest."

I will wait for Vanessa to send me the camera footage before issuing a citation.

Officer Ballweg Reporting #9167:

On March 10th 2025, around 1527 hours, I, Officer Ballweg #9167, was working uniformed patrol for the City of Appleton Police Department. I wore a complete police uniform with all required gear, such as an APD police badge on my chest to identify me as a Police Officer and a department-issued Axon body-worn camera. I was operating my marked patrol squad #1015. I was notified that Vanessa had uploaded the requested security camera footage from the interior of Mr. Frogs. I reviewed the two videos that had been uploaded.

The first video started to record at 0203 hours. It would have already been passed the hours that the bar was allowed to be open. Majority of the patrons could be seen sitting at the bar and talking. Nayeli was observed placing something in front of one of the patrons but does not appear to be asking any of them to leave. There are also no signs of a disturbance taking place inside except for arguing by some patrons, but Nayeli did not appear to be attempting to break that up.

The second video also started recording at 0203 hours on March 3rd, 2025. That video showed the interior of the bar and most of the parties involved in the disturbance are observed outside. They then make their way back into the bar as law enforcement arrived and could be seen running around the interior and toward the back door. The actual time was not shown on the footage, but based on the traffic cameras, it was likely after 0208 hours.

Due to what was observed in the camera footage, I determined that a citation would be issued for

open after hours. Mr. Frogs still had patrons inside and was making no effort to have the patrons leave despite it being after the allowed hours of operation. Nayeli's statements to officers about not being able to shut down on time due to a disturbance inside also does not appear to be the case.
