Original Narrative

On April 26th, 2025, I, Officer Waters 9128, was working as a fully uniformed Officer for the City of Appleton Police Department working the Downtown College Ave Detail. I was positioned at the intersection of N Division St and W College Ave within my marked patrol vehicle facing 409 W College Ave; Mr Frogs. I saw that a verbal disturbance was erupting outside of this bar as the bouncers were kicking a group of females out. I began approaching as this verbal disturbance transpired. As I was approaching, the group of females began throwing punches at each other. I began running toward this group and pulled one of the females off of the other as other Officers pulled the other female away.

I then pulled the female I had pulled away to the side of one of the nearby buildings. I asked her to explain to me what had happened while identifying her. The female appeared distressed as she was crying and appeared injured. She showed me her tooth where it appeared chipped and potentially damaged beyond that. This female was identified verbally as Emma Seymour (DOB: 02/16/2000). Emma had explained to me that she had been minding her own business before her cousin attacked her outside of the bar. Emma later identified her cousin as Anna Popovich (DOB: 03/08/2003).

I asked Emma why her cousin hit her. Emma said she did not know. Emma said that she had been caused pain without consent as a result of the injuries caused by Anna. Emma claimed to have not thrown any punches back at Anna. Additionally, Emma said that she did not want to be a victim of this incident. I then regrouped with other Officers. I was informed that Anna stated she had been in the bar when Emma was making claims that Anna was a bad mother. This began an argument which transpired outside of the bar. A fight ensued between the two shortly after. I was also informed by other Officers that camera footage existed of the incident. I watched this camera footage and it showed that Anna threw the first punch before a total of 4 females began hitting each other.

Two of the females remained on scene while others fled. It appeared in the video that both Anna and Emma were throwing punches at each other after the first punch had been thrown. Neither Emma nor Anna had any interest in pursuing charges against one another. I asked other Officers to search for the other involved parties. They were unable to locate them. Due to the mutual combatants within this situation, acting in a loud and boisterous manner within a populated area, I made the decision to charge both parties with Ordinance Disorderly Conduct. I created citations for both Anna and Emma and issued them accordingly.

I later logged the traffic camera into Evidence and ended my investigation.

SUPPLEMENTAL NARRATIVE:

On Saturday, 4/26/2025, at 00:52 hours, I, Officer R. DiFrancesco (9201) was working as a sworn Patrol Officer for the City of Appleton Police Department. On the above date, I was working the College Ave. detail from Friday, 4/25/2025 at 22:00 hours to Saturday, 4/26/2025, at 03:00 hours. I was working this detail with Officer W. Waters (9218). On the above date and time, we in a marked squad parked on N. Division St. at W. College Ave. facing south towards the College Ave. bars. Specifically, we were across from Mr. Frogs, located at 409 W. College Ave. (City of Appleton).

As I watched the front of Mr. Frogs, I observed there to be a group of women standing outside of the doorway on the sidewalk and a female subject just outside of the doorway to the bar. I heard a female's voice get louder and as I did, simultaneously, Officer M. Ballweg (9167) radioed to keep an eye on the group of people in front of Mr. Frogs. As I watched the group of women in front of Mr. Frogs, I observed the group of women all move out onto the sidewalk. I then observed a physical confrontation ensue between numerous women.

I ran across the street with other officers to intervene in this incident. Once across the street I grabbed onto one of the women. I verbally identified this woman later as Anna Popovich. I handed Anna to Officer C. Christopherson (9156) and began questioning another female subject standing in front of Mr. Frogs. I verbally identified this woman as [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] advised she was out with Anna when they saw Emma and her two friends at Mr. Frogs. [REDACTED] said there was tension inside the bar, but that Emma and her two friends left. [REDACTED] advised Emma

returned and that Emma and [REDACTED] exchanged words inside the bar, which resulted in them being told to leave. [REDACTED] said once outside of the bar, Emma and her two friends were in Anna's face and were recording her, saying how she was a bad mother and that they should call CPS. [REDACTED] said she saw Emma and her two friends get into a physical altercation with Anna and that she intervened to defend Anna. At this time I ended my contact with [REDACTED]

Officer Thor and I went into Mr. Frogs to look for the other two women involved, but did so with negative results. I returned to Officer Waters' location and provided him with the information I obtained. This concluded my involvement with this incident. Axon on.
